

Discord Ordinance

This Ordinance States

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System recognizes the voice over Internet protocol program Discord as the system's primary program for communications. Villoux will operate one Discord server to serve as the predominate base of communications for the system known as "Villoux's Discord Server". Villoux's Discord Server is considered a server property of Villoux's Discord Operation Department; therefore, the Executive Discord Operator as head of the Discord Operation Department shall additionally serve as Discord Server Head of Villoux's Discord Server and is regarded as the top authority on Villoux's Discord Server. All users on Villoux's Discord Server will be added to the "User" role once they have verified their account with the Villoux Operator Bot.

Section 1 - General Information

Weebly Clause

Effective September 2017

The Discord Ordinance will be fully accessible to every user in Villoux due to the nature of the ordinance's clauses directly outlining the behavioral expectations of all users on Villoux's Discord Server. A link to view the current Discord Ordinance on Villoux's website will always be pinned in #villoux_announcements.

COLDHEARTS Clause

Effective September 2017

Users should contact a Discord Operator in the event they need assistance or wish to report another user on Villoux's Discord Server. Discord Operators should be contacted via direct message or verbally and it should take a Discord Operator no longer than five minutes to respond to requests for assistances unless said Discord Operator's Discord status is set as "Idle", "Do Not Disturb", or "Away". Users should contact a Grand Council Member in the event they need assistance when no Discord Operators are online.

Lingual Clause

Effective September 2017

The Lingual Ordinance of the Villoux Bill of Ordinances outlines English, French, and Portuguese as the official languages of the Villoux Server System. All text messages sent on Villoux's Discord Server must be sent in one of these languages, else they will be deleted and considered spam. Users whom are unable to communicate in the aforementioned languages are found automatically guilty of any charge made against them.

Mony459 Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System considers a "system ban" the ultimate punishment within the system. A system ban is a permanent ban from all Villoux owned or operated servers, guilds, tournaments, events, groups, and other properties. System banned users are therefore strictly prohibited from connecting to Villoux's Discord Server and should be issued an indefinite ban for "Ban Evading" in the event they manage to ban evade on the Discord server. The Villoux Chief of Staff should be immediately notified of any such ban evasion. A complete list of system banned users can be found on Villoux's website and any new system bans will be noted in the Discord Operation Newsletter and further information about system bans can be found in the System Ban Ordinance.

Biko Clause

Effective August 2019

Discord's terms of service apply on Villoux's Discord Server. It is the responsibility of the Executive Discord Operator to ensure the Discord Ordinance and the Discord Operation Department adhere to and enforce Discord's terms of service, especially when they are not otherwise noted in the Discord Ordinance.

Crokey Clause

Effective October 2017

Discord automatically assigns a unique client number to every Discord account. Any user whom changes their primary Discord account should make the change known to the Villoux Chief of Staff by submitting a Discord Client Number Change Form.

Quarkk Clause

Effective June 2019

Villoux's Discord Server does not utilize the "server boosting" feature offered by Discord Nitro and therefore discourages users from boosting the server.

RocketSamurai Clause

Effective September 2019

The "Go Live" permission offered by Discord for streaming is denied to every role on Villoux's Discord Server except users in the Grand Council Member role.

Lazar Clause

Effective September 2019

Villoux's Discord Server does not utilize the "NSFW" option offered by Discord for text channels. All text channels are universally moderated in the same capacity and users who post any inappropriate content may be subject to having their message deleted and a Discord ban depending on the severity of the content.

KauriSamson Clause

Effective September 2019

Villoux's Discord Server does not utilize the "slowmode" option offered by Discord for text channels, though users who rapidly post messages risk being charged with "Trolling" if their posts are considered spam.

Section 2 - Channel Information

BaitWizard Clause

Effective September 2017

Villoux's Discord Server will offer categories to separate and organize the voice and text channels on the server. The system's government, each of the system's gaming departments, the Misc. Gaming Section division of the System Press Department, the Board of Executives' staff, and the Radio Villoux division of the System Press Department will all be granted categories on the server. The categories will be listed with the Villoux Government category first followed by each of the gaming departments based on size in the last system census, the Misc. Gaming category, the Villoux Staff category, and the Radio Villoux category. Users are recommended to collapse or mute categories which are not of interest to them, e.g. the Villoux Staff category for users whom do not serve in the system's staff.

System Census Clause

Effective September 2017

Departments which have the same number of users defined in a system census will have their categories listed alphabetically. The misc. gaming category will not change location based on the results of system censuses, regardless of if the Misc. Gaming section has more users defined than a gaming department.

Public Text Channels Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines "public text channels" as any text channel without role-restrictive connectivity. Villoux's Discord Server will offer at least one public text channel for each of the server's categories, except the Villoux Government category. Most public text channels will use "general" as an identifier for the channel, e.g. "osu_general", whereas private text channels will use "staff" or "announcements" to denote the private nature of the channel. Only pertinent content to each category should be posted in its respective text channel. Spamming or posting any content that is deemed inappropriate by other clauses in this ordinance will result in a ban for the appropriate duration. #misc_gaming is considered the "general" text channel for Villoux overall.

All Discord text channels, public and private, will be sorted into their respective categories. #villoux_announcements will be the default text channel under the Villoux Government category and all other text channels will be sorted into categories based on their respective category's standing in Villoux.

Villoux Announcements Clause

Effective September 2017

#villoux_announcements is used to distribute pertinent information about system's events and services to the public. It will be the default text channel on Villoux's Discord Server but posting in #villoux_announcements is restricted to approval granted by the Executive Discord Operator or the Villoux Chief of Staff. Grand Council Members and senior staff members are the only users whom should ever post in #villoux_announcements; however, users whom previously served in one of the aforementioned roles but have since left the system shall not have their messages deleted from the channel.

Villoux Calendar Clause

Effective January 2020

#villoux_calendar is used to display a calendar with a complete list of events being sponsored by Villoux in the coming month. Reminders about these events will be posted in #villoux_announcements as appropriate, but users can view a full month's calendar by viewing this text channel. The Villoux Chief of Staff is the only user authorized to post in this channel.

Villoux Information Clause

Effective June 2019

#villoux_information is used to display pertinent information about the system and its services. Information in the form of messages will list general information about Villoux's Discord Server, including a link to the Discord Ordinance on Villoux's website, and links to Villoux's Facebook page, Steam group, website, and TeamSpeak server. Each gaming department will also be listed with pertinent links and information for the respective department. The Villoux Chief of Staff is the only user authorized to post in this channel.

Private Text Channels Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines “private text channels” as text channels wherein only certain roles may view the messages within the text channel. Villoux’s Discord Server will offer private text channels for members of system staff and server staff whom need a forum to communicate privately. The Grand Council, the House of Players, and the Baskerville Cabinet will be granted private text channels under the Villoux Government category and the Discord Operation Department, the System Coding Department, and the System Press Department will be granted private text channels under the Villoux Staff category. Users who have been added to the “Banned” role on Villoux’s Discord Server will only be able to view #banned_console, which contains a message explaining they have been temporarily banned from using the server until their ban expires. Any additional private text channels will be granted at the discretion of the Executive Discord Operator and the Villoux Chief of Staff. Private text channels may only be accessed by appropriate users and any user accessing a private text channel in which they are not permitted may be charged with “Trespassing”. The Villoux Grand Council and the Discord Operation Department will have permission to view every private channel in order to monitor them, though they are subject to charges of “Trespassing” if they abuse their permissions to send messages in text channels in which they would not otherwise have permission to send messages or “Distribution of Private Information” if they discuss the content of said text channels. The Discord Operation Department will not have access to view #grand_council.

Public Voice Channels Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines “public voice channels” as any voice channel without role-restrictive connectivity. Villoux’s Discord Server will offer at least one public voice channel for each of the server’s categories, except the Villoux Government category. Public voice channels are granted to all gaming departments sponsored by Villoux, the Misc. Gaming Section division of the System Press Department, and the Radio Villoux division of the System Press Department. Public voice channels may be used for any general, off-topic conversation until a user joins the channel that is actively playing what the channel sponsors. All off-topic conversations should be moved to a different public channel once a user that is actively playing the game sponsored by the channel joins.

The Misc. Gaming voice channel serves as the general public voice channel on the server and may host any form of conversation. Public voice channels may not have restricted connectivity, edited voice activity, or have access to any other aspects of Discord's advanced permissions.

Private Voice Channels Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines "private voice channels" as any voice channel wherein only certain roles may connect to and or see the voice channel. Private voice channels are divided into four categories: user private voice channels, staff voice channels, group voice channels, and government voice channels. No form of private voice channels will be granted to users who do not meet the requirements outlined this clause.

User private voice channels are granted to all Server Heads and Grand Council Members. All user private voice channels are named "<Username>'s Private Channel". Gaming department staff's user private voice channels are placed under the appropriate category for each respective Department Chairmen and Server Head, Executives' user private voice channels are placed under their respective staff's staff voice channel in the Villoux Staff category, and the Villoux Chief of Staff's user private voice channel is placed under the Villoux Government category.

Staff voice channels are private channels used by the system's staff to hold staff meetings, discuss ongoing projects, and interview prospective staff members. Staff channels are granted to each department under the Board of Executives in the Villoux Staff category.

Group voice channels are granted to groups that meet and maintain the requirements set forth in the Discord Ordinance.

Government voice channels are channels used by the Villoux Server System for official government business such as House of Players meetings and Grand Council meetings. Government voice channels are the most private channels on Villoux's Discord Server; therefore, any user found in a government voice channel without proper permission will be prosecuted with a Discord ban for "Trespassing".

DuXaaa Clause

Effective August 2019

All members of the Discord Operation Department and the Villoux Grand Council will be granted permission to view all private text channels but will only be granted permission to type into text channels relating to their position, though their authority is still fluid in the text channels in which they cannot type. The Executive Discord Operator and the Villoux Chief of Staff are granted permission to type into all text channels.

NolanEaston Clause

Effective September 2017

User private voice channels are to be used for the owner of the channel's idling, brief discussion of private information, holding staff meetings, or for issuing user punishment. User private voice channels are not to be used for idle chitchat, non-system related matters, or personal discussions.

InstaPwn Clause

Effective September 2017

Private voice channels of Grand Council Members may be used to engage in gaming events of games sponsored by the system that require strategic planning in order to provide a peaceful atmosphere where users may not cause burdens; however, once the event is over, the users should leave the private voice channel. It should be noted that this clause affects only private voice channels, not staff or government channels.

Orcrypt Clause

Effective September 2017

Villoux Realm of the Mad God guilds will be granted one private voice channel and one private text channel on Villoux's Discord Server, pursuant to the Cronus Clause of the Realm of the Mad God Ordinance. The guild channels will be sorted alphabetically. Guilds with voice channels that regularly reaches fifteen users at a given time in their voice may have their Realm of the Mad God Guild Master request a secondary guild voice channel. Appropriate secondary channel names include: Dungeon Runs Channel, Guild Leaders Channel, Recruitment Channel, and Trading Channel.

Approval from first the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman and then either the Executive Discord Operator or the Villoux Chief of Staff must be granted for any channel other than the aforementioned. Additional secondary voice channels may be granted for each increment of five users regularly in the guilds channel's traffic. It is the responsibility of the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman to report the activity of each group to the Chief of Staff in order to ensure proper administration.

Each Realm of the Mad God Guild Master will be granted a role specific to their guild. The Guild Master will then be eligible to add all of their guild's members to a Discord role specific to their guild, though it should be noted that this role does not reflect an actual staff position within the system. Members of Discord Operation Department, the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, or the Villoux Chief of Staff may also add guild members to this role if they verify the user is in the guild via RealmEye. It should also be noted that the Guild Masters and members have the ability to join all guild channels, but the only channels they should join without invitation are their own guild channels.

EggTech Clause

Effective September 2017

The Realm of the Mad God category on Villoux's Discord Server offers a private voice channel to groups of users whom wish to rune private tombs, dungeons, shatters, and other events in Realm of the Mad God, the "Dungeon Running Channel", pursuant to the EggTech Clause of the Realm of the Mad God Ordinance. The Dungeon Running Channel may only be used by groups of at least two users to run private dungeons on production Realm of the Mad God. Only users participating in the event may join the channel and users must vacate the channel once the event is over. Use of the channel operates of a first come first serve basis and any Realm of the Mad God Department-sponsored event maintains first rights to use the channel, even if other users are currently occupying it. Users whom meet these standards may contact a Realm of the Mad God Dungeon Master, member of the Discord Operation Department, the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, or the Executive Discord Operator to utilize the channel.

Fredrik Clause

Effective September 2017

League of Legends teams may be granted private voice channels for their ranked teams within the League of Legends category on Villoux's Discord Server if they are able to maintain Villoux standards. The team channels will be sorted alphabetically. In order to achieve Villoux standards, the group must: have at least five users on Villoux's Discord Server; have a team name that does not violate the KirinaeWindstalker Clause, Pbarron88 Clause, or Spree Clause of the Discord Ordinance; and receive approval from the League of Legends Department Chairman. The channels may be used for gameplay or casual chit-chat but may not host a number of users far exceeding the number of team members in the channel. Teams which neglect to maintain these standards will be granted one week to achieve the standards again. All of the teams' channels will be deleted if the teams fail to return to Villoux standards in one week.

Each team captain will be granted a role specific to their team. The team captain will then be eligible to add all of their team's members to a role specific to their team, though it should be noted that neither team captain nor member of the team reflect an actual staff position within the system. Members of Discord Operation Department, the League of Legends Department Chairman, or the Villoux Chief of Staff may also add team members to this role. It should also be noted that team captains and members have the ability to join all team channels, but the only channels they should join without invitation are their own team channels.

Sullivan Clause

Effective August 2018

Every Minecraft server owned or operated by the Villoux Server System will be granted one text channel and one voice channel within the Minecraft category on Villoux's Discord Server. The Minecraft Department Chairman may request the Executive Discord Operator grant additional channels to Minecraft servers with a large presence on Discord.

SargentJ5 Clause

Effective June 2019

Towns and kingdoms on Villoux's Minecraft server Villoux Kingdoms will be granted text channels within the Minecraft category on Villoux's Discord Server if they are able to maintain Villoux standards. The community channels will be listed alphabetically. In order to achieve Villoux standards, the community must: have at 10-20+ residents in the community on Villoux Kingdoms; have a community name that does not violate the Kirinae Windstalker Clause, Pbaron88 Clause, or Spree Clause of the Discord Ordinance; and receive approval from the Minecraft Server Head of Villoux Kingdoms or the Minecraft Department Chairman. Communities which neglect to maintain these standards will be granted one week to achieve the standards again. All of the communities' channels will be deleted if the communities fail to return to Villoux standards in one week.

Cookiewillnom Clause

Effective November 2019

Villoux Destiny 2 clans will be granted one private voice channel and one private text channel on Villoux's Discord Server, pursuant to the Cookiewillnom Clause of the Destiny 2 Ordinance. The clan channels will be sorted alphabetically. Clans with voice channels that regularly reaches fifteen users at a given time in their voice may have their Destiny 2 Clan Master request a secondary guild voice channel. Appropriate secondary channel names include: Raid Channel, Clan Staff Channel, and Recruitment Channel. Approval from first the Destiny 2 Department Chairman and then either the Executive Discord Operator or the Villoux Chief of Staff must be granted for any channel other than the aforementioned. Additional secondary voice channels may be granted for each increment of five users regularly in the guilds channel's traffic. It is the responsibility of the Destiny 2 Department Chairman to report the activity of each group to the Chief of Staff in order to ensure proper administration.

Each Destiny 2 Clan Master will be granted a role specific to their clan. The Clan Master will then be eligible to add all of their clan's members to a Discord role specific to their guild, though it should be noted that this role does not reflect an actual staff position within the system. Members of Discord Operation Department, the Destiny 2 Department Chairman, or the Villoux Chief of Staff may also add guild members to this role if they verify the user is in the clan. It should also be noted that the

Clan Masters and members have the ability to join all clan channels, but the only channels they should join without invitation are their own clan channels.

Deviationlark Clause

Effective September 2017

Villoux's Discord Server utilizes the misc. gaming category for potential Department Chairman to work on establishing their potential department to apply to Villoux. Channels within the misc. gaming category merely represent department concepts and are not officially recognized by the system as official departments. Consult the Lyllox Ordinance for additional information on the misc. gaming category.

Emrict245 Clause

Effective September 2017

Users may not purchase channels or roles on Villoux's Discord Server. The system appreciates donations to its servers, but donations may not be made directly to Villoux's Discord Server. Donations should instead be made to other Villoux servers or the general fund of the Villoux Grand Council.

Section 3 - Channel Restrictions

Phil Clause

Effective September 2017

Villoux's Discord Server may not be used as grounds for recording verbal content or streaming, unless dictated otherwise by the Executive Discord Operator or the Villoux Chief of Staff. Users found recording or streaming on the Discord server will be kicked from the server immediately with the message "Recording/streaming is not permitted".

System Commercialists may record and stream in the System Commercialist Channel voice channel but may only record or steam in that channel. Commercialists are allowed to invite other users into the Commercialist channel to record or stream with them. They should rely on system officials to move users into the channel for them.

Joepr9 Clause

Effective September 2017

Department Chairmen maintain the right to issue a “department ban” against users. Department bans prohibit the banned users from accessing any servers, guilds, tournaments, or other events offered by the department; accessing the text and voice channels within the department’s category on Villoux’s Discord Server; and being counted as a user in the department’s system census. Users issued department bans will be assigned a role called “Department Banned from X” with “X” replaced with the respective department. This role prohibits the user from entering voice and text channels within their banned department’s category on Discord. It is the responsibility of Department Chairmen to report department banned users to the Executive Discord Operator and it is the responsibility of the Executive Discord Operator to keep the Discord Operation Department informed of all active department bans via the Discord Operation Newsletter.

Cheezcake117 Clause

Effective October 2018

The priority speaker feature will be restricted on Villoux’s Discord Server. The Villoux Chief of Staff shall have access to use priority speaker throughout the server, though this is the only role with such permission.

Jibram Clause

Effective October 2017

Villoux’s Discord Server will not use a server widget or any other similar feature that would display a list of active users on the Discord server to promote user privacy and security.

Section 4 - Bot Information

Cronus Clause

Effective September 2017

Villoux’s Discord Server employs the use of automated clients referred to as “bots” to execute various functions across the Discord server. Any user may request for a bot to be installed, but it is ultimately the discretion of the Executive Discord Operator upon the advice of the Villoux Chief of

Staff to decide which bots will be utilized by the server. Bots which can be used by anyone can be accessed via any text channel. All bots will be assigned the role “Discord Bot” on Villoux’s Discord Server. Bots’ nicknames will state the bot’s name followed by a space and “Bot”. Bots will have a gear emoji next to their username rather than a flag emoji. It should be noted the Villoux Server System did not create all bots employed by its Discord server nor does it have control over the bots’ avatars, custom statuses, or messages.

Each bot on the Villoux Discord server will have a clause named after it in this section explaining the bot’s purpose in Villoux, whom may access the bot, and the commands necessary to utilize the bot. All bots have a “prefix”, which is a symbol used to preface commands and direct them to the proper bot. Accessing any features of a bot not directly discussed in its respective clause will be considered an “Abuse of Permissions”.

Clyde Bot Clause

Effective October 2017

Clyde Bot is the default bot that assists Discord users and is present on every Discord server, including Villoux’s Discord Server, though it is not displayed in the client list. It is responsible for notifying users when they try to attempt something unsupported by Discord and basic administrative functions. The Villoux Server System has no control or influence over this bot.

Villoux Operator Bot Clause

Effective October 2017

The Discord Operator Bot is used to verify users, set ban durations, and perform other administrative functions on Villoux’s Discord Server. The bot is nicknamed “Villoux Operator Bot” (V.O.B.) on Villoux’s Discord Server. V.O.B.’s prefix is “-”. V.O.B. sends a welcome message to all new users who join Villoux’s Discord Server explaining how to verify their account on the Discord server to be added to the “User” role. Users type “-verify <username> <country code>” without the quotation marks or brackets in #verification_console in order to verify their accounts.

Members of the Discord Operation Department and Grand Council Members are the only users eligible to utilize V.O.B.’s administrative functions and are granted access to do so by being added

to the “Villoux Operator Bot User” role on Villoux’s Discord Server to utilize its functionalities. It should be noted this bot replaces the default protocol for the Discord application’s ban. V.O.B. is grouped in the Discord Operation Department role rather than the Discord Bot role since it has administrator privileges. The command to ban a user is: `-ban <Discord ID> <#> <hours/day> <reason>`” without quotation marks or the brackets. Discord’s developer mode must be enabled on the client-side in order to copy user’s Discord IDs. All V.O.B. commands should be typed in `#vob_command_console`. V.O.B. will then add the user to the “Banned” role, which restricts the user from connecting to any voice channels and viewing or sending messages in any text channels without removing them from the Discord server outright. The banner will then format a ban report in `#vob_command_console`. The banner should then use the IFarmmy Clause of this ordinance to format a Discord ban report using the command `-banreport`. V.O.B. will then prompt the user with the ban report commands, `“-banreport <#> <reporter> <Discord ID>”` is used for the reporter of the banned, `“-banreport <#> <description>”` is used to type a brief description of the events leading to the ban, and, finally, `“-banreport <#> submit”` is used to submit the ban report, which will be posted by V.O.B. as a message in `#discord_ban_reports`. Ban reports should be submitted immediately after a ban is issued. V.O.B. will remove the user from the banned role and reassign any previous roles once the ban has expired.

Other V.O.B. commands include:

1. “-elly”, which lists the ban durations for every charge
2. “-help banreport”, which lists the commands used to submit a ban report;
3. “-banreason <charge>”, which provides the clause in the Discord Ordinance for the requested charge, e.g. “-banreason Trolling” will display the LordJHary Clause of the Discord Ordinance and “-banreason” can be used to list all charges;
4. “-help”, which lists all V.O.B. commands

Dyno Bot Clause

Effective October 2017

Dyno Bot is used to record all actions on Villoux’s Discord Server. Dyno Bot posts messages with each action in `#discord_server_log` on the Discord server.

Simple Poll Bot Clause

Effective November 2017

The Simple Poll Bot is used by system officials to survey users on certain subjects. Polls may only be created by system officials and must be pertinent to their respective departments. All questions and responses should be professional as they are representative of the system. Simple Poll Bot's prefix is “/”.

Groovy Bot Clause

Effective September 2019

Groovy Bot is used by Radio Villoux DJs to play music on Villoux's Discord Server in appropriate channels. The bot is nicknamed “Radio Villoux Bot” on Villoux's Discord Server. The bot is only accessible to Radio Villoux DJs, the Radio Villoux DJ Manager, the Executive System Press Officer, the Executive Discord Operator, and the Villoux Chief of Staff through being added to the “DJ Bot User” Discord role and should only be used in the Radio Villoux voice channel or permitted private voice channels. Radio Villoux Bot's prefix is “!”. Use “!help” in #radio_villoux for a list of Radio Villoux Bot's commands.

Boat Bot Clause

Effective November 2019

Boat Bot is available for any user on Villoux's Discord Server to use. It displays users' Osu! stats and game data. Boat Boat's prefix is “=”. Use “=help” in #osu_general for a list of Boat Boat's commands.

YAGPDB Clause

Effective January 2020

YAGPDB.xyz Bot is used to assign pingable roles to users on Villoux's Discord Server. All other functionalities of YAGPDB Bot are disabled on the server. YAGPDB's prefix is “*”.

Section 5 - Nicknames and Client Restrictions

TheHatchling Clause

Effective September 2017

All users are to use the username of their system-defined department on Villoux's Discord Server, pursuant to the System Name Ordinance. Users whom play multiple games within the system with different usernames in different games are required to use one system name. Non-English, French, or Portuguese characters in usernames must be translated to one of the aforementioned languages to remove the foreign characters. Users may not put other usernames next to their system name in the parenthesis or brackets unless their system name includes the additional usernames. Users whom join Villoux's Discord Server to play a game not sponsored by the system and users whom use anonymous names in their system-sponsored game must use their original Discord username. Users whom change their in-game name may contact the Villoux Chief of Staff to apply for a system name change. Consult the System Name Ordinance for additional information regarding system-defined names.

Kuladir Clause

Effective September 2017

Users on Villoux's Discord Server verify their username with a nationality, indicated by the two-letter initial of their nationality which translates to an emoji of the flag for their nationality. Users with dual-nationalities should choose the nationality of their preferred country as only one flag will be displayed by usernames. Some users may not be able to view the flag emojis and instead view blocks or the country code. It should be noted the only flags and nationalities that will be recognized by the Villoux Server System are noted in the System Nationality Ordinance. Users whom possess a nationality without an emoji flag will have the white flag emoji next to their username, pursuant to the Silent Clause of the System Nationality Ordinance. Users may change their nationality by contacting the Villoux Chief of Staff to apply for a system nationality change.

XStarOcean Clause

Effective September 2017

Users with usernames deemed inappropriate by the Pbaron88 Clause, Spree Clause, KirinaeWindstalker Clause, or Zedl Clause of this ordinance will be required to change their Discord username to an otherwise desired username which does not violate the aforementioned clauses. Users must request a system name change from the Villoux Chief of Staff prior to using their new username.

Q Clause

Effective September 2017

The Discord application requires all usernames to have under thirty-two characters. Users whom have usernames exceeding thirty-two characters will only have the first thirty-two characters of their name displayed on Villoux's Discord Server, but their fully username will be used in all Villoux records.

Cali Clause

Effective September 2017

Users are only allowed to have one account connected to Villoux's Discord Server at any given time. Users with other users living within their IP addresses should have separate accounts for each individual user. It is recommended users simply login to their PC Discord account on the mobile Discord app. rather than creating a second account. Users with more than one account connected will have the least active account kicked from the server with the message "Duplicate account". Re-connecting the account to the server risks having both accounts banned for "Refusing to Cooperate".

DeadRusher Clause

Effective October 2017

The Villoux Chief of Staff will be the only user with access to mention "@everyone" in an effort to ensure the feature is not abused to send spam on Villoux's Discord Server.

ABCUSEEME Clause

Effective December 2017

The ability to send text-to-speech messages is disabled on Villoux's Discord Server in an effort to ensure the feature is not abused to send inappropriate messages.

Section 6 - Avatar and Message Restrictions

Cosmic Clause

Effective September 2017

Users whom display avatars, post messages, display game names, display custom statuses, or display any other media connected to Discord on Villoux's Discord Server which violate any of this ordinance's clauses will have their message deleted or be requested to change their avatar or game name by a member of Discord Operation Department. The Discord Operator will inform the user why their avatar, message, or game name is inappropriate by direct messaging the user on Discord, or verbally engaging in conversation. Users whom refuse to delete inappropriate avatars or set their avatars as ones that were previously requested to be removed will be banned for "Refusing to Cooperate".

Pbarron88 Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the following words and any variation of these words as profanity: bitch, cock, cunt, dick, fuck, hoe, penis, piss, pussy, shit, slut, tits, and whore. Users should refrain from using profanity when speaking in a professional setting, in their avatar, custom status or username, when posting emoji reactions, and when administrating other users, but the use of profanity in text channels is not be strictly regulated unless it is considered harassment against another user.

Spree Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System strictly prohibits the display of the following offensive symbols or any variation or reference to said symbols: Al-Qaeda (AQAP), Antifa, Boko Haram, burning crosses,

burning flags, the Confederate States of America, the Islamic State (ISIS/ISIL), Ku Klux Klan (KKK), lynching, middle fingers, Nazism, swastikas and terrorist attacks. The following symbols may be used to promote offensive agendas but are not inherently offensive without proper context: fried chicken, mayonnaise, pentagrams, purple Kool-Aid, and watermelon. The Discord Operation Department will use its own discretion on a case by case basis for these potentially offensive symbols. Users found in violation of this clause will be banned for “Harassment”.

Icyx Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System does not tolerate the use of any of the following words or derivatives of these words in a derogatory manner: adopted, conservative, gay, Jew, homosexual, lesbian, liberal, Muslim, and tranny. The following words and derivatives of these words may not be used on any Villoux owned or operated service: coon, dyke, faggot, kike, nigger, and retard. Users whom use these words derogatorily will be banned for “Harassment”.

KirinaeWindstalker Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System strictly prohibits the display or distribution of pornography, including the following anatomical parts: anus, nipples, penis, testes, utter, and vagina; the following actions: blow jobs, coitus (in any form [i.e. oral, anal, etc.]), ejaculation, and licking another being; and the following objects: dildos, flesh lights, lubes, semen, sexual toys, and sperm. It should be noted that any life forms indulging in these actions will be accounted as pornographic, regardless of them being human or not. Users whom violate this clause will be banned for “Distribution of Pornography”.

Zedl Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System strictly prohibits the display of or allusion to the following vulgarities: abortions, birthing, bleeding, burning, defecation, flatulence, nose picking, urination, and vomiting. Users whom violate this clause will be banned for “Trolling”.

Trashcan Clause

Effective November 2018

Users whom post messages which violate any clauses within this ordinance and then edit or delete the inappropriate message in an attempt to avoid punishment will not be excused from the violation. Members of the Discord Operation Department can view all edited and deleted messages in #discord_server_log as posted by Dyno Bot and will handle the situation as if the message was never edited or deleted.

Steve Clause

Effective October 2017

Posting emojis or other images which allude to any of the aforementioned prohibited content is considered violating the respective clause it would violate.

IronRain Clause

Effective September 2018

Villoux's Discord Server will not employ or allow the use of any custom emojis not in the default Discord emoji pack unless otherwise specified. The one exception to this clause is the "Villoux" emoji.

Purehearts Clause

Effective September 2017

Users whom play games with default inappropriate names according to the Spree Clause, Pbarron88 Clause, KirinaeWindstalker Clause, or Zedl Clause of this ordinance will be requested to disable the display of said game on Discord. Users whom refuse to oblige with this clause will be banned for "Refusing to Cooperate".

Section 7 - Ban Offenses

Ruince Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of a user intentionally using their granted permissions on any Villoux owned or operated services without permission or with intent to cause harm on said owned or operated service as an “Abuse of Permissions”. Users may also be charged with “Abuse of Permissions” should they find an exploit that allows them to access permissions otherwise unavailable. The ban duration will be decided by the Executive Discord Operator and the Villoux Chief of Staff but may not exceed thirty-days.

Lluke156 Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of posting information regarding non Villoux-owned or -operated gaming communities, Discord servers, or gaming servers as “Advertising”. Connection information does not have to be posted in order to be charged with “Advertising”; the mere discussion of external communities is prohibited. The ban duration for “Advertising” is thirty days.

Kaneki Clause

Effective November 2019

Users on Villoux’s Discord Server are not permitted to advertise giveaways, donation drives, raffles, or other similar events being hosted by exterior communities or individual users without direct consent from the Executive Discord Operator or the Villoux Chief of Staff. Violation of this rule will result in the violating user being prosecuted with a charge of “Advertising”.

Zaaeen Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of users connecting to a Villoux server from which they were banned as “Ban Evading”. Users whom ban evade a ban will be issued a second ban for double the ban duration of the original ban for “Ban Evading”, e.g. a user issued a two hour ban whom reconnects to Villoux’s Discord Server via another account during the lapse of the ban will be issued

a four hour ban for “Ban Evading”. Users whom ban evade a ban for “Ban Evading” will be banned for thirty days unless the double time for their original ban exceeds thirty days. Users whom ban evade thirty days risk being prosecuted with a system ban by the Executive Discord Operator.

MunchyBro Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of a user threatening to inflict harm onto another user or reveal private information about another user if said user does not oblige to demands as “Blackmail”. The threatening user may also be charged with “Distribution of Private Information” if the information falls within the scope of the WarriorScaryMe Clause of this ordinance. The ban duration for “Blackmail” is thirty days.

Pjxxx1128 Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of a system staff member accepting money, items, favors, or other goods/services in payment for using their position in a certain way as “Bribery”. Both the user offering the bribe and the user that accepts the bribe may be charged with this offense. The user attempting the bribe can be charged regardless of whether or not the bribe was accepted; alternatively, system staff members encouraging bribes will face likewise punishment. The ban duration for “Bribery” is thirty days and staff members found to have accepted or initiated a bribe will be demoted from their position.

Tauerpower Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of rapidly connecting and disconnecting from either voice channels or Villoux’s Discord Server as “Connection Spam”. The ban duration for “Connection Spam” is one hour.

DagsonB Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of attempting to sway users in one Villoux-sponsored guild to another Villoux-sponsored guild in the same game as “Counter-Recruitment”. Villoux guilds in the same game should aim to support one another, not steal users and slander each other. The ban duration for “Counter-Recruitment” is one day.

sssNoMaDsss Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of intentionally spreading false malicious statements about another user, a department, or the system as “Defamation”. Other users whom know the information is false but continue to spread it will also be charged with “Defamation”. Any user whom repeats the information but is unaware that it is false is free from this charge but may be charged with “Harassment” or “Distribution of Private Information” depending on the circumstances. The ban duration for “Defamation” is two hours for each user whom the defaming user spread the malicious statements.

Spazproof Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of excessive rudeness or aggression towards members of the Discord Operation Department or Grand Council Members in a professional setting as “Disrespect to System Officials”. The ban duration for “Disrespect to System Officials” is two hours.

Cnx4Mia123 Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of issuing other users mods, clients, or hacks as “Distribution of Hacking Mods/Clients”, especially if the distribution occurs on Villoux’s Discord Server. The distribution of the aforementioned is prohibited, though users may employ their user on non-Villoux owned or operated services without recourse. The ban duration for “Distribution of Hacking Mods/Clients” is one hour.

WarriorScaryMe Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines another user intentionally revealing otherwise unknown and private information as “Distribution of Private Information”. It is strictly prohibited to distribute another user’s personal information such as IP addresses, current business or home residences, phone numbers, pictures, or online profiles without the consent of said user. Resources such as profiles from Villoux-sponsored games (including Steam), email addresses, or personal pictures set as avatars by users do not fall into this category, regardless of their ability to be used to trace any of the aforementioned information. It should be clearly noted users may distribute their own personal information to whomever they feel worthy and may not be charged with “Distribution of Private Information” for distributing his or her own information. The distribution of sensitive Villoux information such as answers to the Discord Operator Test, any Villoux owned or operated account’s password, Grand Council verdicts or operations, and the happenings within any official Villoux meeting is likewise considered “Distribution of Private Information”. The ban duration for “Distribution of Private Information” is one week.

Axew6000 Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of a user repeatedly trolling another user or personally attacking another user as “Harassment”. Users whom are routinely being harassed by the same user are recommended to mute the harassing user on Discord. The ban duration for “Harassment” is two hours.

Bruno Clause

Effective September 2017

Users whom are unsatisfied with the manner in which a Discord Operator handled a situation should report the Discord Operator to the Discord Operative Manager or the Executive Discord Operator, not another Discord Operator. Calling a second Discord Operator to a case already resolved by another Discord Operator may be considered “Harassment” against the Discord Operation Department.

MeTric Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of gathering information in relation to any Villoux service or member of staff and providing it to a foreign community as “Espionage”. Espionage may be anything as severe as system secrets or something as simple as the number of users connected to Villoux’s Discord Server. Users may be charged with both “Espionage” and “Distribution of Private Information” if the information falls within the scope of the WarriorScaryMe Clause. The ban duration for “Espionage” is one week.

Finic Jr. Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of fabricating a user’s identity or position in Villoux to be more influential than it is in reality as “Impersonation”, especially if a user is attempting to impersonate a specific individual or a system official. The act can be performed by verifying themselves as a different user on Villoux’s Discord, asserting authority in an unauthorized fashion, or agreeing to obtain permissions intended for someone. The ban duration for “Impersonation” is one week.

Ianbobtron Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of intentionally spreading mistruths, speculated gossip, or otherwise made-up stories to system officials as “Lying to System Officials”. The ban duration for “Lying to System Officials” varies between one week and thirty days depending on the severity and the impact of the lie. The Executive Discord Operator and the Villoux Chief of Staff make the determination of the ban duration.

Difly Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines any noise coming from a user’s microphone other than their normal speaking voice as “Mic. Spam”. Common examples of mic. spam include barking, clicking,

crying, ruffling, breathing, blowing, singing, screaming, typing, and voice changers. The ban duration for “Mic. Spam” is one hour.

Gooky Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of failing to comply with given orders by a system official as “Refusing to Cooperate”. This charge covers all acts of resistance from failing to provide requested information to not complying with given orders. It should be noted Grand Council Members outrank Discord Operators and the Discord Operative Manager and are therefore exempt from being banned for “Refusing to Cooperate” by a member of the Discord Operation Department; however, the Executive Discord Operator and the Villoux Chief of Staff may ban other system officials with this charge. The ban duration for “Refusing to Cooperate” is two hours.

Grazey Clause

Effective September 2017

Users may request to be issued a ban from Villoux’s Discord Server if users genuinely believe they will cause problems for the system. It should be noted that this clause should not be applied to joking situations or applied in areas where it is unnecessary. The ban duration for “Requesting Ban” is eight hours.

Calebbeen Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of a user taking goods from another user without giving the user the goods the original user offered as “Scamming”. A member of the Discord Operation Department will request the scamming user to return the scammed items upon being notified of the scam. Refusing to return the items may result in an additional ban for “Refusing to Cooperate”. It should be noted in-game scams must have transpired over Villoux’s Discord Server either through text channels, voice channels, or direct messages via the server in order for this charge to be applied to Discord and are not required to have taken place in a Villoux-sponsored game or on a Villoux-owned or -operated service. The ban duration for “Scamming” is one hour.

Dolphin Clause

Effective November 2019

The Villoux Server System will issue a permanent Discord ban for “Spam Bot” against any bot that joins Villoux’s Discord Server to send direct messages to users on the Discord server or messages in public text channels. In the event of an influx of bots from another community, it is advised that the Villoux Chief of Staff upon the advice of the Executive Discord Operator elevates Villoux’s Discord Server’s moderation permissions to the highest level, requiring phone verification for users to send direct messages to other users on the server, until the influx of bots has subsided. It should be noted that this is only a temporary measure.

RecruitQEB Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of accessing any channel without proper approval as “Trespassing”. Any user whom is not a member of staff using staff channels, with the exception of users recording with a Commercialist or users being interviewed or administrated, shall be charged with “Trespassing”; likewise, any member of Villoux using any of the channels within the government category without the Chief of Staff’s approval will be charged with “Trespassing”, with the exception of official meetings occurring in the House of Players and Grand Council channels and official board meetings in the Courthouse channel. Users in user private channels without the owner of said channel present may also be charged with “Trespassing”. It should be noted joining a channel without permission via abusing permissions to join said channel should be classified under the more serious charge of “Abuse of Permissions” opposed to trespassing. The ban duration for “Trespassing” is one day.

LordJHary Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Server System defines the act of intentionally annoying or attempting to annoy another user as “Trolling”. The act of rapidly posting messages, known as “spamming”, falls under this charge as well. The ban duration for “Trolling” is one hour.

Wrench Clause

Effective April 2019

The Villoux Server System defines the act of a user registering for an official system-sponsored event and then failing to attend the event as “Truancy”. This charge may only be used for events for which a user explicitly confirmed their availability such as registration for an Osu! tournament or a Radio Villoux DJ registering for a DJ timeslot and then the user failed to attend the event for which they registered without prior notification to the event’s organizer. The ban duration for “Truancy” is one hour.

A&SRoofing Clause

Effective September 2017

Any user whom violates the Discord Ordinance whilst under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be issued an eight-hour ban rather than the otherwise appropriate ban duration in order to allow the user to sober themselves except in cases wherein the appropriate ban duration would exceed eight hours. The user’s ban should be formatted the same as a regular ban with no additional charges being noted in their ban reason; however, the fact that the user was under the influence of drugs or alcohol should be stated in the ban report. It should be noted it is not prohibited to use Villoux’s Discord Server whilst on drugs or alcohol, and users may only be banned using this clause if they begin to cause issues.

Gator Grease Clause

Effective May 2018

Users whom violate the Discord Ordinance through the use of an official Villoux Server System email account are eligible to be banned on Villoux’s Discord Server given there is no mechanism to punish wrongdoings via system email accounts despite them being a Villoux owned service.

8 - Ban Proceedings

ScionWish Clause

Effective September 2017

It should be very clearly noted Discord Operators' main prerogative on Villoux's Discord Server is to ensure peacefulness. It is in that nature Discord Operators should seek a resolution to conflicts without employing a Discord ban but are not to refrain from issuing a ban when it appears to be the only solution to a problem. Discord Operators should try kicking disruptive users from the server as a warning before issuing a ban against them if the disruptive users are only committing minor offenses.

MystiA Clause

Effective September 2017

It should be noted system officials may not administrate other system officials that are their equal or hold higher position. The only exceptions to this are the Discord Operators and the Discord Operative Manager when they are on Villoux's TeamSpeak 3 Server, at which point the TeamSpeak Operators outrank both positions; conversely, the Discord Operators outrank the TeamSpeak Operators and the TeamSpeak Operative Manager on Villoux's Discord Server. Grand Council Members' superiority is fluid on both TeamSpeak and Discord.

Elly Clause

Effective September 2017

The following list contains appropriate ban durations for Discord bans. Bans may include multiple offenses, pursuant to the XxOwtLawwwxX Clause of this ordinance.

One-Hour Ban: "Connection Spam", "Distribution of Hacking Mods/Clients", "Distribution of Pornography", "Mic. Spamming", "Trolling", and "Truancy"

Two-Hour Ban: "Defamation", "Disrespect to System Officials", "Harassment", and "Refusing to Cooperate"

Eight-Hour Ban: Acting defiantly whilst under the influence of drugs/alcohol and "Requesting Ban"

One-Day Ban: “Counter-Recruitment”, “Lying to System Officials”, “Scamming”, and “Trespassing”

One-Week Ban: “Distribution of Private Information”, “Espionage”, and “Impersonation”

Thirty-Day Ban: “Abuse of Permissions”, “Advertising”, “Blackmail”, “Bribery”, “Lying to System Officials”

Permanent Ban: “Spam Bot”, system banned users ban evading their system ban

Neonkeii Clause

Effective September 2017

Users whom proceed to mute a system official whilst said system official is investigating an incident in relation to said user risk being found automatically guilty of the respective charge due to choosing to not communicate with the system official. It should be noted this would also be the case if the user had the system official muted prior to the incident occurring. It is highly recommended that all users refrain from muting system officials to avoid this situation.

Pwnzy Clause

Effective September 2017

Users whom are being issued bans from Villoux’s Discord Server must first be moved to the -Discord Operation- voice channel and be informed of the reasons for their ban. The Villoux Courthouse voice channel or the Executive Discord Operator’s private channel may be utilized if they are unoccupied if -Discord Operation- is otherwise being utilized. The Villoux Chief of Staff may issue Discord bans from his private channel. Users whom behave aggressively or inappropriately during this time may be additionally banned for “Refusing to Cooperate” or “Disrespect to System Officials”. Users whom are being banned but are not in a voice channel will receive a direct message from the user banning them explaining their charge and punishment.

XxOwtLawwwxX Clause

Effective September 2017

Users whom are being banned for multiple offenses will have their ban duration reflect each ban individually, e.g. a user being banned for both “Trolling” and “Refusing to Cooperate” will have their ban duration extended to three hours rather than one hour or two hours. There is no limit as to how many charges may be applied to a user at a given time.

DrPibb Clause

Effective September 2017

Users whom have been issued three previous Discord bans will be banned for one week opposed to the normal ban duration in the event they are issued a fourth Discord ban, except in the case that the normal ban duration would exceed one week. Users whom have been issued four previous Discord bans will be banned for thirty days opposed to the normal ban duration in the event they are issued a fifth Discord ban, except in the case that the normal ban duration would exceed thirty days. The Executive Discord Operator will consider prosecuting a system ban against users whom have been issued six Discord bans. Any subsequent bans after a user’s sixth Discord ban will also be made for thirty days opposed to the normal ban duration, except in the case that the normal ban duration would exceed thirty days.

McNaughton Clause

Effective September 2017

System banned users whom have their system ban appealed or pardoned by the Villoux Grand Council are not subject to the DrPibb Clause of this ordinance for their previous bans. Returning system banned users will have any subsequent Discord bans issued for the normal ban duration until the DrPibb Clause reapplies to them. It should be noted the user’s bans will remain recorded in the Villoux User Reports and the user’s System Ban Record.

IFarmmy Clause

Effective September 2017

The Executive Discord Operator must be made aware of all bans on Villoux's Discord Server in the form of a ban report. The ban report should be formatted as follows: username of banned user, Discord client number, nationality of banned user, system position of the banned user (if none, list "user"), charge, description of the events, date, user that banned user, banner's rank, user that reported user, reporter's rank, ban duration. The Executive Discord Operator will then relay the reports to the Villoux Chief of Staff whom will enter the ban record into the Villoux User Reports. The ban reports should be given to the Executive Discord Operator as soon as possible. Failure to submit ban reports may result in a demotion from the Discord Operation Department and a ban for "Abuse of Permissions". Ban reports are submitted via the Villoux Operator Bot.

Orangutan Clause

Effective September 2017

Charges may not be brought against a user if the clause regulating said offense was not active at the time the act was committed, e.g. if a user committed an offense in January, but there was not a clause that prohibited that offense until May, the user may not be charged with said offense as it was not prohibited at the time the user committed it.

Section 9 - Staff Information

Armazard Clause

Effective September 2017

All users within the Villoux Server System serving in system staff positions will be awarded a role on Villoux's Discord Server to reflect their respective staff positions. These roles will have varying colors and permissions based on their respective positions. No gaming department or staff division may use the same color roles at the same time. The color of each gaming department and staff division are to be decided upon by the respective Department Chairman or Executive and the Villoux Chief of Staff with advice from the Executive Discord Operator. The biggest element for consideration when selecting a color should be the game's visual art style and logo's colors. The permissions for each role will vary depending upon staff ranking and necessary permissions to

effectively serve the position. The Chief of Staff with the advice of the Executive Discord Operator will determine each role's permission set. It should be noted roles on the Discord server are not necessarily indicative of system staff positions. The current color classifications are as follows:

Baskerville Cabinet - burgundy (default burgundy)

Destiny 2 Department - baby blue (#CFFEFF)

Discord bots - white (default white)

Discord Operation Department - purple (default purple)

League of Legends Department - dark blue (#26068f)

Minecraft Department - brown (#713200)

Osu! Department - light pink (#f564b5)

Realm of the Mad God Department - red (#fd0404)

System Art Design Department - hot pink (#ff05e3)

System Coding Department -dark green (default dark green)

System Press Department - light blue (default light blue)

Team Fortress 2 Department - orange (#ff6a06)

TeamSpeak Operation Department - TeamSpeak gray (default dark gray)

Users (including all non-system staff roles) - white (default)

Villoux Grand Council - gold (default gold)

Scrub Lord Corey Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Chief of Staff is the only user on Villoux's Discord Server authorized to assign and remove roles on the server reflective of system staff positions in order to ensure administrative

stability and maintain accurate and cohesive records. The Executive Discord Operator maintains the right to remove users from system staff roles in the event said users are abusing the permissions associated with their role and the Chief of Staff is unavailable. The Executive Discord Operator should immediately notify the Chief of Staff of the removal.

CaseyEaston Clause

Effective September 2017

The owner of an account is responsible for the actions done on the account, regardless of the user actually executing the actions, pursuant to the CaseyEaston Clause of the Unity Ordinance. Users are exempt from this clause in the event it can be proven the account was hacked.

Dr. Wilson Clause

Effective September 2017

Users whom wish to become a Discord Operator must take the Discord Operator Test and score at least 80% correct. The Discord Operator Tests are jointly maintained by the Executive Discord Operator and the Villoux Chief of Staff. Each Discord Operator Test is comprised of twenty questions which assess the user's general knowledge of how the Discord Operation Department functions. Three individuals must be present for a Discord Operator Test to be administrated: the test's administrator, the user taking the test, and a proctor. The administrator must be either the Discord Operative Manager, Executive Discord Operator, or the Chief Staff and the proctor must be either the Discord Operative Manager or a Grand Council Member. The test's questions and results may not be discussed by the administrator, proctor, or tester after the test has been concluded. Sharing questions, answers, or scores will be considered "Distribution of Private Information" and is punishable by a Discord ban. Any user on Villoux's Discord Server is eligible to take the test, but the Executive Discord Operator maintains the right to refuse to offer the position of Discord Operator to users whom pass the test in the event the Executive Discord Operator believes the user would not serve the Discord Operation Department well.

April Clause

Effective September 2017

The Villoux Chief of Staff maintains the right to exempt users from the Dr. Wilson Clause of this ordinance if the Executive Discord Operator can provide sufficient evidence the Discord Operation Department is understaffed to the point of effecting the administrative stability of Villoux's Discord Server, pursuant to Grand Council Ruling #191972.

Loli Dragon Clause

Effective November 2017

Users must manually verify their Discord accounts before being able to use Villoux's Discord Server, pursuant to the Villoux Operator Bot Clause of this ordinance. Verifying a user's account adds them to the "User" role. Verification occurs in the text channel #verification_console, which is only viewable by unverified users and system officials. Discord Operators should check the text channel at least once every time they are online to see if there are any unverified users online. Discord Operators should direct message any online unverified users to offer assistance in the verification process.

Solvausta Clause

Effective September 2017

At least one Discord Operator should be present during any regularly scheduled Radio Villoux events, pursuant to the Nexemonsta Clause of the Radio Villoux Ordinance. The Radio Villoux DJ Manager is responsible for organizing all staff for the event, including Discord Operators, but should confer with the Discord Operative Manager or the Executive Discord Operator when requesting Discord Operators for the events. Discord Operators whom notice no other Discord Operator is present in the Radio Villoux voice channel during a Radio Villoux event should join the channel and moderate it.
