**Transition: We will open tonight's meeting with the Department Updates, starting with the system's largest department, the League of Legends Department. Whereas we would generally move to the King of TeamSpeak and League of Legends Department Chairman, the honorable Mr. Flosion, we will instead turn to the Baskerville Advisor of League of Legends, Mr. Pwnzy to present the League of Legends Department Update on Mr. Flosion's behalf.**

*League of Legends Update as read by Pwnzy*

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. As mentioned by the Right Honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, I will be presenting this evening's League of Legends Department Update on behalf of our new League of Legends Department Chairman. The new Chairman is a familiar face, one that has been in Villoux for the better half of four years. Being reassigned from his position as Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, the honorable Mr. Flosion is very excited to begin his tenure as League Chairman. Mr. Flosion will be replacing our former League of Legends Department Chairman, Mr. ChewOnDiss, who was, unfortunately, demoted due to inactivity. Mr. ChewOnDiss served as Department Chairman for the League Department for a total of six months, and the Grand Council wishes to express their thanks to his work during that time. However, like all good things, it was time for his tenure as Chairman to come to an end. Mr. Flosion aims to execute Mr. ChewOnDiss' goal of increasing the number of Americans and Canadians in the League Department, as, despite League still being the most populous department in the system, they are presently at an all time low. Mr. Flosion believes that increasing the American and Canadian userbase will in turn increase the number of participants for the monthly 1v1 and 5v5 tournaments. Throughout Mr. ChewOnDiss' tenure as League Chairman, the American and Canadian population has dwindled down severely, thus causing the participation for our American tournaments to be very low. Mr. ChewOnDiss did very little to increase the number of American and Canadian users, which is something Mr. Flosion aims to do the opposite of. Mr. Flosion plans to launch numerous types of campaigns to attract a large number of American and Canadian League users to Villoux. Despite the American and Canadian numbers being low, the League Department does boast an extremely high number of European users, namely from Finland, Portugal, and Estonia, respectively. In the past, Mr. ChewOnDiss proposed having tournaments for the European users, but has had no positive feedback from the users themselves. Therefore, the Department shall continue to rely on American and Canadian tournaments. Mr. Flosion also plans to continue to expand the number of team channels sponsored by Villoux, specifically the number of American and Canadian team channels. In fact, now would be the prime opportunity to remind the House that any ranked team in League of Legends may apply for a ranked team channel, as long they have five members of their team that are active on Villoux's TeamSpeak server. The final note I have been requested to make is that Mr. Flosion is presently looking to hire some League of Legends Tournament Directors. If you know any users that would be interested in that position, please direct them to Mr. Flosion's attention. With that, I thank the House for giving me the privilege to present you the League of Legends Department Update, and will yield my time.

Presenting the Realm of the Mad God Department Update on behalf of the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. ScionWish is the Realm of the Mad God Guild Master of the Sanguine Sanctuary Guild, Mr. Asdern.**

*Realm of the Mad God Update as read by Asdern*

Thank you for the introduction, and good evening to you all. As stated, my name is Asdern and I serve as the Realm of the Mad God Guild Master of the Sanguine Sanctuary Guild. Unfortunately, the newly instated Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. ScionWish, was unable to attend tonight's meeting due to work related issues, so it has become my honor to present the update on his behalf. However, before we get into the Department Update, I would like to take a moment to recognize Mr. ScionWish. Mr. ScionWish has been serving as a Villoux TeamSpeak Operator for the past three months, and has been a member of Villoux for the past six months. Mr. ScionWish obviously is a member of the Realm of the Mad God Department, and has been playing the game for the past two years with an average daily gameplay of about three to five hours, making him one of the most qualified candidates for the position as Department Chairman. As my respectable colleague Mr. Pwnzy mentioned in his League of Legends Department Update, Mr. ScionWish will be replacing the honorable Mr. Flosion upon Mr. Flosion's reassignment to League of Legends Department Chairman. Mr. Flosion, the Executive TeamSpeak Operator, Sen. Ace, and the Right Honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville have both stated that they have nothing but the utmost confidence in Mr. ScionWish's ability as Chairman. His introduction aside, there are a few goals that Mr. ScionWish hopes to accomplish as Department Chairman. His first goal is to create a more respectable environment throughout the Villoux Realm of the Mad God community, citing the fact that it has had a rather notorious reputation throughout its history in the system. His second major goal is to engage the community in hosted public events on a frequent basis. He feels as if this will help bond the community together, thus making it a happier atmosphere. Finally, he wishes to help alleviate the workload on the TeamSpeak Operation Department by maintaining peace and order throughout the Realm of the Mad God Department by utilizing his experience as a TeamSpeak Operator. With the achievement of these goals, Mr. ScionWish feels as if he will oversee what could be one of the most successful Realm of the Mad God Department's in Villoux history.

Without further ado, I shall now present the Realm of the Mad God Department Update. The first order of business I have been requested to speak on is welcoming the new Realm of the Mad God Tomb Master, Mr. Dannyoung into his position. As many of you are aware, it is the role of the Tomb Master to update the Tomb Channel password so that regular Realm users may utilize the channel to run tombs in a private environment. Mr. Dannyoung will be replacing our former Tomb Master, Mr. Darkpupit upon Mr. Darkpupit being promoted to Guild Master of our newest guild, the High Tier Guild. Most active on the US South server, the High Tier Guild has joined Villoux as our newest guild, and hosts users from an array of different nationalities. Upon the instillation of the Sanguine Sanctuary and Mundane Guilds, a new US East public channel has been opened. We hope that this new public channel will help meet the need for public channels within the Realm spacer. The Mundane and RealmAdmins Guilds have both been granted Dungeon Runs channels, a returning feature to the department. Dungeon Runs channels are private channels granted to any guild that exceed fifteen users that are both active in TeamSpeak and in game on a daily basis. There is no limit to the amount of Dungeon Runs channels that any given guild may have, and each guild may request Dungeon Runs channels for each increase in increments of five users that they receive past ten. For example, if a guild had twenty active users on a daily basis, they could request to be granted two Dungeon Runs channels. Mr. ScionWish aims to make guild communication more effective by implementing this ability, thus reducing the amount of clutter in each guild channel. Finally, it is with regret, that I announce the disbandment of the Kings Mans Guild, and thus the demotion of their Guild Master, Mr. EIWin. The guild failed to maintain Villoux standards, and was promptly removed earlier this month. With that being said, I thank Mr. ScionWish for granting me the opportunity to present this moth's update to the House, and hereby conclude my Department Update. Thank you.

## *Minecraft Update as read by Afecter*

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. It is my privilege to present this month's Minecraft Department Update on behalf of the Minecraft Department Chairman, the honorable, Mr. Crokey. The Minecraft Department has undergone a sort of purge this month, with both of our former Server Heads being demoted. Although we have yet to hire replacements for them, we have decided to re-launch one of Villoux's oldest and most historic Minecraft servers, Basic Craft. It has become my responsibility to administrate Basic Craft as its Server Head. My plan is to keep Basic Craft's roots as a simple survival server, but focus more on the community aspect of the server over the survival. I feel as if by making Basic Craft a community server we will be able to attract not only users from other Villoux departments, but also non-Villoux Minecraft users to the system. With the assistance of the Executive System Builder, the honorable Mr. Smudd and the Right Honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville, Mr. Crokey and I plan to focus on building Basic Craft's userbase, and implementing said userbase into Villoux staff positions, such as Minecraft Builder, Press Officer, and System Coder. Once we have brought Villoux's Minecraft staff levels back up to par, Mr. Crokey plans to expand the Minecraft Department to offer more servers, and continue to make significant progress on our other two existing servers, Drug Craft and the Obsidian Network. In the meantime, both Drug Craft and Obsidian Network are without Server Head. If you or anyone that you know is interested in applying for a Server Head position for either of these servers, please contact Dr. Baskerville. Until we have Server Heads for those servers, no progress will be made towards their release. Basic Craft, however, is set for Villoux-Beta testing release next Friday. I would like to thank Mr. Smudd and the Coding Manager, Mr. Jdaca for their great assistance in preparing the server for its launch. We look forward to a very successful release on Friday, and will be in touch with more details soon. With that being said, I hereby conclude the Minecraft Department Update, and thank you for your time.

## *Team Fortress 2 Update as read by Crazycat*

Thank you for the introduction, and good evening to you all. Although Mr. Zalzam could not be here tonight, I am pleased to present this month's Team Fortress 2 Department Update. Due to Mr. Zalzam's inactivity, the Right Honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville has named me acting Chairman of the Team Fortress 2 Department. This that whereas I am not officially recognized as TF2 Department Chairman, I am allowed to act with the same authority as the Department Chairman within the Department. As acting Department Chairman, I have been working closely with the Executive System Coder, Mr. JynX123 in preparing the Main Server for release. I am pleased to announce that the Main Server is up and running, and ready for users. In the absence of an adequate Press Department, Dr. Baskerville and I have been having a bit of trouble populating the server. We will continue to try to find methods to advertise the server, and are open to any recommendations from the House, especially of popular TF2 YouTubers/livestreamers. As we have seen in the Realm of the Mad God Department from Mr. SLVRDLLR's videos, Commercialists are a great way to expand any department. Another way that we aim to expand the department is by reviving our monthly Team Fortress 2 tournaments. Under Mr. Zalzam's reign as Chairman, the tournaments have become forgotten and sloppy. I plan to restore the tournaments to their former glory, and ensure their success. Sadly, we will not be able to host a tournament this month, but do plan to host one in April. If you would like to register for the tournament, please send me a private message after tonight's meeting. Whilst on the topic of tournaments, I would like to take this time to announce that I am presently seeking individuals to help me administrate our tournaments as TF2 Tournament Directors. If you know anyone that plays TF2 and might be interested in this position, please contact me. The Tournament Directors are an extremely helpful part of hosting a successful tournament, so I strongly urge the House to assist me in selecting some. In a final recap, both our Main Server and tournaments are back to running smoothly, so I invite and encourage all members of the House to check them out! I would be more than happy to join any and all of you on our servers, and look forward to seeing many of you in our upcoming tournament. I appreciate you allowing me to give the Team Fortress 2 Department Update, and yield my time to the floor.

## *TeamSpeak Announcement as read by Duncan Wallace*

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. It is with great delight that I come before you yet again to present the TeamSpeak Announcement. The month of March has been a very progressive month for the TeamSpeak Operation Department. I call the month progressive for many reasons, but chiefly due to the fact that we have discontinued the position of TeamSpeak Helper, thus enabling users to progress to the status of TeamSpeak Operator much more quickly. Ever since the rank was established in 2012, it has proven to do very little but serve as dead time before serving as an Operator. Initially designed to help train users to serve as better Operators, throughout the past three years, we have found that the position did very little to actually help prepare Operators. Now opposed to taking Helper Tests, potential Operators take TeamSpeak Operator tests. The same rules that applied to Helper Tests now apply to Operator Tests, such as the test being comprised of twenty questions, users having to score at least 80% correct to pass the test, and the test being able to be retaken once a week. Our newest Operators have been hired directly as such, and we have seen no issues with this thus far. Speaking of our newest Operators, I would like to take this time to publically welcome our newest members to the Operation Department, Mr. Steve and Mr. Zaaeen. Both gentlemen have been serving as Operators throughout the past month, and have been doing so diligently. Likewise, the other members of the Operation Department have stayed very focused and active throughout this past month, and have not failed to bring a successful air of order to the TeamSpeak server. Sen. Ace and the Executive System Coder, Mr. JynX123 have made the entire TeamSpeak Ordinance publically available on Villoux's website. You may access to download link to the TeamSpeak Ordinance by clicking the link that I am posting in chat now - <http://villoux.net/userforms/index.html>. Whereas it is not necessary or recommended that you read every portion of the TeamSpeak Ordinance, it is good to familiarize yourself with it's basic principles. We recommend that you make use of Microsoft Word's "find" function and simply search for keywords that are relevant to the rule you wish to read. The final order I have been asked to discuss is Villoux's Remind101. Although many of you are already subscribed to our Remind101, several of you are not. Remind101 is a text-notification feature available to anyone with a mobile phone. Simply text the number I am posting in chat (769-447-2540) @villoux – that's "at sign" Villoux. By subscribing to this number, you will be texted important reminders about upcoming meetings, tournaments, server releases, and other critical information. There are no charges to users in foreign countries, and your number cannot be viewed by anyone once you have subscribed. It is entirely safe and private. Well, with that being said, I hereby conclude my TeamSpeak Announcement, and thank you for your time and cooperation.
