Good evening, and thank you for joining me at tonight's meeting. Since the month of May proves to be an extremely busy month filled with exams, graduations, traveling, and tight work schedules, I will make tonight's meeting as brief as possible. The main purpose of tonight's meeting will be to review the system census, followed by a brief update on each of our gaming departments. Without further ado, let us begin tonight's meeting with the results of our system census.

As I am sure you are all aware, every three months the system holds a system census to survey elements such as the amount of users in the system, how diverse the system is in regards to nationality, and which departments are bringing in the largest amounts of user. The requirements for a user to be defined in the system census, as outlined by the System Census Ordinance in the Villoux Bill of Ordinances, are as follows: "In order for a user to be counted in a department, the user must have been active in Villoux for at least one month prior to the census, must use the Villoux TeamSpeak server regularly, and must not be issued a hiatus or be inactive in the system for excess one month. If a user violates any of the above stated, he/she is ineligible to be counted in the System Census." Now that you have a better understanding of the census, I shall proceed with this month's results.

The month of May yielded tremendous results. In January of 2016, Villoux saw a minor decline from September of 2015's record 350 users. It brings me great honor and happiness to announce tonight that Villoux has far surpassed our previous record of 350 users. As of May 2016, Villoux has exactly 501 users that are eligible to be counted in tonight's census. The system never ceases to amaze me at how large it can grow and gives me nothing but the utmost confidence that we shall have no problem in maintaining Villoux's standards of excellence in the coming months. Villoux hosts the largest public Realm of the Mad God TeamSpeak server, we have a booming League of Legends Department, and our Counter Strike and Minecraft Departments continue to develop to great heights. It amazes and enthralls me what people from around the world can do when we unite together to game.

Specific to each department, the Realm of the Mad God remains Villoux's largest department by far with a massive 255 users, an over 100 user increase from January's 154 users. I would like to commend the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. Meowzo and the Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters, Mr. BigAsh, Mr. Vendii, Mr. Axott, and Mr. XXCabeXx for their contributions and hard work in assisting us reach this new height. The League of Legends Department remains the second largest department, and also reports a growth from January's 92 users to 109 users. Once we instate new administration in the League of Legends Department, I am certain that we can not only regain those eight lost users, but also expand far beyond that. The Counter Strike Department remains the third largest department, also reporting a noticeable growth from January's 54 users to 80 users. The Counter Strike Department Chairman, Mr. Blubber Socks deserves much appreciation and recognition for the major advancements he has made since his installation as Department Chairman. Finally, the Minecraft Department remains Villoux's smallest department, but also saw a growth from 27 to 29 users. There were 28 users that were non-defined, meaning that they use Villoux's TeamSpeak server regularly, but do not belong to any specific department. Percentage wise, the Realm of the Mad God Department supplies Villoux with 51% of total user base, the League of Legends Department supplies 22% of total user base, the Counter Strike Department supplies 16% of total user base, the Minecraft Department supplies



6% of total user base, and 5% of the users are non-defined. We had a total of 501 users from a total of 42 different countries around the globe. I would like to thank this time to recognize those countries. They will be listed by the number of Villouxians from them, beginning with the country with the most Villouxians: the United States of America, the Commonwealth of Australia, the State of Canada, the Republic of Finland, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Republic of Portugal, the Kingdom of Belgium, the Commonwealth of New Zealand, the Kingdom of Sweden, the Republic of Estonia, the Republic of Germany, the Republic of Ireland, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the Kingdom of Norway, the Federative Republic of Brazil, the State of Israel, the State of Japan, the Republic of France, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of Poland, the Republic of Slovenia, the United Arab Emirates, the United States of Mexico, the Republic of Austria, the Republic of Bulgaria, the Republic of Serbia, the State of Ukraine, the Republic of Croatia, the Kingdom of Denmark, The Republic of Greece, the Republic of Iraq, the Sultanate of Oman, the Federal Republic of Nigeria, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the Republic of South Africa, the Republic of Korea, the Republic of Cuba, and the Dominican Republic.

Before concluding the census results, I would be amiss if I did not thank those members of the House that provided major assistance in recording this month's census, especially the Baskerville Assistant, Mr. Staek; the Operative Manager, Mr. Oupas; the Executive Baskerville Assistant, Mr. ScionWish; the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. IronRain; and the Counter Strike Department Chairman, Mr. Blubber Socks. I humbly thank you gentlemen for your contributions, and would like to congratulate the members of the Chairman Committee on a job well done.

With the census results aside, I will now provide a brief update on each of our four gaming departments, beginning with the largest department, the Realm of the Mad God Department. As mentioned earlier, the month of May proves to be very busy for all of us, and the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. Meowzo is no exception. He has been on a hiatus for the month due to personal reasons, but plans on returning at the very beginning of June. Since he has been absent, no monthly shatters event was hosted this month. We did, however, see a major hike in the number of guilds Villoux sponsors. Upon returning, Mr. Meowzo plans to continue to work with our Guild Masters to grow their guilds and ensure their stability and longevity.

Our second largest department, the League of Legends Department, has recently suffered the loss of their Department Chairman, Mr. SoulSniper214, who was demoted from his position earlier this evening for inactivity. Per result of Mr. SoulSniper's neglect of his department, no tournaments were hosted on any region. Whereas we do not currently have a replacement for Mr. SoulSniper, I myself will become the acting League of Legends Department Chairman and strive to hire regional Tournament Masters, specifically from Western Europe, North America, and Oceania. From these Tournament Masters, I hope to find our new League of Legends Department Chairman. If you would be interested in applying for this position or have a recommendation for someone you feel would fill this role well, please contact me after tonight's meeting.

The Counter Strike Department suffers a similar problem to the League of Legends Department, but for different reasons. Opposed to lacking the necessary administration, the Counter Strike Department lacks the necessary number of teams to host productive regional

tournaments. The Counter Strike Department Chairman, Mr. Blubber Socks is currently working diligently with the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. IronRain on growing his department, but failed to meet the goals needed to host any regional tournaments this month. Over the course of the next month, Mr. Blubber Socks plans on hiring several regional Counter Strike Tournament Directors and the lacking Counter Strike Tournament Masters. Through his new staff, he hopes to be able to host as many tournaments as possible as quickly as possible.

Finally, our Minecraft Department has currently been moving very slowly due to the Minecraft Department Chairman, Dr. Afecter's hiatus for work-related issues. Dr. Afecter will be returning in mid-June and plans on continuing progress on our three Minecraft servers. In fact, he will be serving as the Server Head of Villoux's upcoming Feed the Beast: Infinite server, Project Onyx: Infinite. More information about that server will be released upon his return. Our second server, the Villoux Penitentiary, Villoux's prison server, is in the last leg of its development phase and should also be ready for release when Dr. Afecter returns. The Server Head of the Villoux Penitentiary, Mr. Coiz deserves recognition for the dedication and quality of the work he has provided for his server. The final Minecraft server, the Villoux Township, recently lost its Server Head, Mr. Wifi90876. The server aims to be a simple server community-themed server geared to Villoux users. If you are interested or know anyone who may be interested in running this type of server, please contact me after tonight's meeting.

I would like to thank each of the member of the house for their attendance at tonight's meeting, but I would specifically like to take this time to thank and announce this month's Friend of Villoux. As you know, the Friend of Villoux award is a monthly award given to a member of Villoux's staff that has gone above and beyond in their respective field. It gives me great pleasure to announce that this month's Friend of Villoux is the Baskerville Assistant, Mr. Staek. Along with those mentioned earlier, the assistance that Mr. Staek provided is what enabled us to successful record and examine this month's census. For your great contribution to the Baskerville Cabinet and to Villoux, Mr. Staek, I thank you. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank you – the hard working members of Villoux's staff that make Villoux a system in which "excellence is your only option". With that in mind and in heart, I, the Right Honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville do hereby adjourn this 48<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Villoux House of Players.
