54th House of Players Meeting as Read by Dr. Baskerville

Good evening, my fellow House of Players members. As we gather here tonight to celebrate and note our system's accomplishments for the month of November, I would like to take a moment to reflect on one of the American's recent holidays, Thanksgiving. For those unaware, Thanksgiving is a holiday in which Americans gather with family and "give thanks" for all of the good things in life. Everything as materialistic as their home and cars to life itself. It is a time for introspection and appreciation. This Thanksgiving, I found myself being thankful for many things, but the staff in the Villoux Server System was certainly amongst the top of my list. To be able to serve a system with as excellent staff as we have is truly a privilege and an honor that I do not take lightly. Part of the way that I express thanks is declaring the month of December as a "month of rest", meaning that during the month, no Villoux sponsored activities, meetings, or other events will occur. Similar to Thanksgiving, there are several holidays in December that warrant our time being best spent with our families, friends, and neighbors. It is in this reason that I always believe it best to leave Villoux solely as a place of community, not of business or politics, during that month. However, there are still a few days left in November, so let us make the most of them by having a productive meeting tonight.

Due to a lack of availability with our Department Chairmen, I will be presenting each department's department update personally. As standard protocol, we will begin with the system's largest department, the Realm of the Mad God Department. Our Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. Silent has been working tirelessly across his department, with a major emphasis on our two private servers – Lylox's Realm and Villoux's Realm. Unfortunately, there has recently been a major upset with some of the Lylox's Realm Developers, resulting in one of them attempting to sabotage Lylox's Realm's VPS. The individual in question has been removed from his staff position and all other staff are currently undergoing investigation to ensure that no such issues can occur in future. In the meantime, the server will remain down for security reasons so that the staff can repair any damage done to the server. Mr. Silent and his staff hope to have Lylox's Realm back online very soon. The other private server, Villoux's Realm, is nearing its final stages of development. The Server Head of Villoux's Realm, Mr. Meapy, has also been working with his staff to complete the server's new source and ensure that it is stable and secure for users. Private servers aside, our Realm of the Mad God Department has also been enjoying high TeamSpeak traffic largely in part to one of our new guilds, The Pot Hoovers Guild. Led by Guild Master, Mr. Ocript, the guild has a vast international appeal, bringing in users from Europe and North America alike. Despite The Pot Hoovers Guild doing very well, Villoux saw the disbandment of the department's two other guilds due to a lack of members in both guilds. As noted above, since December is our month of rest, Mr. Silent will begin working with the Press Department to campaign for more guilds in the new year. The one job that Mr. Silent does have for the month of December is hiring Dungeon Masters to oversee our Dungeon Running channels during various time zones. Last month, the House successfully recommended our new North American Dungeon Master, Mr. ImNubby to his position, so Mr. Silent would like to call upon the House to make additional recommendations for a European and an Oceanic Dungeon Master at tonight's meeting. If you have individuals to recommend for either of those positions, please make note of them during the questions, comments, and concerns portion of the department update; and, without further ado, let us move to the questions, comments, and concerns period for the Realm of

the Mad God Department. If you have a question, comment, or concern, please message me “question”, “comment”, or “concern”, respectively. Thank you.

Seeing as there appear to be no further questions, comments, or concerns per regards our Realm of the Mad God Department, let us now move to our second largest department – the League of Legends Department, which has recently received a new Department Chairman. First joining Villoux nearly four years ago and formerly serving as one of my Baskerville Advisors, Mr. Zickerly has been named the new League of Legends Department Chairman, finally filling a vacancy in that position that has lasted for the past six months. Like Mr. Silent, come January, Mr. Zickerly will have his work cut out for him. His most immediate goal will be reestablishing Villoux’s monthly North American League of Legends tournaments, requiring him to hire three North American Tournament Directors. Once the North American tournaments have returned to a normal schedule, Mr. Zickerly will begin hiring Tournament Masters to assist in expanding the tournaments to the Oceania server and the European Nordic and East server. Though Mr. Zickerly is aware that these ambitions will take time, he is dedicated to his cause, making me believe that he has everything he needs to succeed. As a side goal, Mr. Zickerly will also aim to increase the number of team channels offered on our TeamSpeak server. I imagine that he will be partnering with our Press Department to do so. In the meantime, Mr. Zickerly will be focusing on getting adjusted to his new position. With that being said, let us move to the questions, comments, and concerns period for the League of Legends Department. Seeing as there appear to be no further questions, comments, or concerns per regards our League of Legends Department, I will take just a brief time to make note of our third largest department, the Counter Strike Department. Similar to our League of Legends Department, our Counter Strike Department is currently suffering an unusually long period without a Department Chairman. Though December is supposed to be a month of rest, I plan to spend much of my time during that month seeking a user that can accept the Chairman position in January. I hope to have more news about the department at that time. We will move to a brief period for questions, comments, and concerns per regards the Counter Strike Department. Without any further questions, comments, or concerns pre regards the Counter Strike Department, we will now move to the system’s smallest department, the StarBreak Department. Within his first month as StarBreak Department Chairman, Mr. ScionWish has already made leaps and bounds across his department. Under his leadership, the first StarBreak guild has joined Villoux, the Spicy Touch Guild, led by their Guild Master, Mr. SeaDragnX. Mr. ScionWish hopes to employ his experience as Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman to help expand the StarBreak Department to host multiple guilds, exactly as the Realm of the Mad God Department did under his leadership. Another example of him taking notes from his time as Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman is Mr. ScionWish’s successful attempt to host a department wide mission run this month. Mr. ScionWish partnered with the StarBreak Mission Master, Mr. Kareta to host a Graveyard Mission run, an event attended by several members of the StarBreak Department. In January, Mr. ScionWish plans to host another such event and expects an even greater attendance. Despite being the system’s smallest department, the StarBreak Department is

certainly blossoming into a successful example of Villoux's innovation and ability to expand. With that being said, let us move to the questions, comments, and concerns period for the StarBreak Department. With there being no further questions, comments, or concerns per regards our StarBreak Department, we will now conclude the department updates portion of tonight's meeting and move to our closing ceremonies. As I noted earlier, Mr. Zickerly has joined our Grand Council as the new League of Legends Department Chairman, however he is not the only recent Council appointee. The former Operative Manager, Ms. ABCUSEEME has also been promoted to Executive TeamSpeak Operator, replacing the previous Executive TeamSpeak Operator, Mr. Oupas. Unfortunately, Mr. Oupas' new work schedule provided little time for his responsibilities in Villoux, forcing the Grand Council to make the disappointing decision to retire him. Though Mr. Oupas will certainly be missed, the Grand Council is very confident in Ms. ABCUSEEME's ability and looks extremely forward to working with her. One of Ms. ABCUSEEME's first acts as Executive was to purge the department of inactive staff, a decision long overdue. Regrettably, this has left her department with only one staff member, the TeamSpeak Operator, Mr. DemonKingz. Whereas most members of the Council will be resting during December, Ms. ABCUSEEME will still be hard at work looking to fill the fourteen vacant TeamSpeak Operator positions and Operative Manager position. In the meantime, the other Grand Council Members and myself will be providing as much assistance to her as we can. We also request patience and understanding from our users during this period when it comes to resolving user issues. Despite only serving as Executive TeamSpeak Operator for a few hours, Ms. ABCUSEEME has already proven how much of a hard-worker she is. Speaking of hardworking members of the system, at this time, I would like to take this time to thank and announce this month's Friend of Villoux. As you know, the Friend of Villoux award is a monthly award given to a member of Villoux's staff that has gone above and beyond in their respective field. It gives me great pleasure to announce that this month's Friend of Villoux is the System Art Designer, Sen. Johni. Sen. Johni's work is displayed throughout Villoux – everywhere from our TeamSpeak server, to our website, our Facebook page, and our private Realm of the Mad God servers. Sen. Johni's work helps keep our system true to its motto, which leads me to take this opportunity to thank you – the hard working members of Villoux's staff that make Villoux a system in which "excellence is your only option".
