## *System Census Results as Read by Dr. Baskerville*

Good evening, my fellow Villouxians. As I am sure you are all aware, every three months the system holds a system census to survey elements such as the number of users in the system, how diverse the system is in regard to nationalities, and which departments are bringing in the largest amounts of user. The requirements for a user to be defined in the system census, as outlined by the System Census Ordinance in the Villoux Bill of Ordinances, are as follows: “In order for a user to be counted in a department, the user must have been active in Villoux for at least one month prior to the census, must use the Villoux TeamSpeak or Discord server regularly, and must not be issued a hiatus or be inactive in the system for excess one month. If a user violates any of the above stated, he/she is ineligible to be counted in the system census.” Now that you have a better understanding of the census, I shall proceed with this month’s results.

The month of September’s results were simply fantastic! At the time of our last census in May of this year, we had a total of 317 active users. This month, the system has a total of 367 active users, an increase of 50 users! This notable increase is due in large part to the hard work of our System Press Department, the dungeon runs hosted by our Realm of the Mad God Department, and the re-establishment of the Minecraft Department.

Specific to each department, the Realm of the Mad God Department remains the system’s largest department with a total of 126 active users, about a ten-user increase from May. The League of Legends Department remains the system’s second largest department, trailing just behind the Realm of the Mad God Department with a total of 118 active users, just over a ten user increase from May. The Counter Strike Department remains the system’s third largest department with a total of 41 active users, a six-user increase from May’s 35 users. The Minecraft Department has become the system’s fourth largest and therefore smallest department with a total of 16 active users. There is a total of 67 active users categorized as “non-defined”, meaning they belong to no gaming department. This number is up eleven-users from May. Percentage wise, the Realm of the Mad God Department provides Villoux with 34% of total user base, the League of Legends Department provides 32%, the Counter Strike Department provides 11%, the Minecraft Department provides 4%, and 19% of users are non-defined.

The system has a total of 367 users from a total of 48 different countries around the globe, including every inhabitable continent on Earth. I would like to take this time to recognize these countries by stating their name and the percentage of Villoux that they represent: the United States of America – 56%; the Commonwealth of Australia, the State of Canada, and the Republic of Estonia – 5%, respectively; the Republic of Portugal and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland – 4%, respectively; the Federative Republic of Brazil and the Republic of Finland – 3%, respectively; the Federal Republic of Germany – 2%; the Republic of Hungary, the Kingdom of Sweden, the Kingdom of Belgium, the Republic of Chile, the Republic of France, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, the Republic of Austria, the Kingdom of Denmark, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of the Philippines, and the United Mexican States – 1%, respectively; and, finally, the Republic of Argentina, the Kingdom of Bahrain, the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Republic of Ukraine, the Republic of India, the Republic of Indonesia, the Republic of Ireland, the Republic of Italy, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Montenegro, the Kingdom of Norway, the Kingdom of Jordan, the Sultanate of Oman, the Kingdom of Nigeria, the Republic of Romania, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the Republic of Serbia, the Republic of

Korea, the Republic of Turkey, the United Arab Emirates, the Republic of Poland, the Dominican Republic, the Republic of Iraq, the State of Israel, the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, and the Republic of Viet Nam – 0.3%, respectively.

Before concluding the census results, I would be amiss if I did not thank those members of the House that provided major assistance in recording this month's census, especially the System Coder, Mr. Silent; the Minecraft Department Chairman, M. Sullivan; the Executive Baskerville Assistant, Mme. Shortylyons; and the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. Fulfi.

## *Realm of the Mad God Update as Read by Fulfi*

Thank you and good evening, everyone. As the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville reported in the system census results, our Realm of the Mad God Department has been growing at a very respectable rate over the course of the past three months. As Department Chairman, I am proud to share in the credit for this wonderful growth, but I would also like to extend my appreciation to members of my department that should be acknowledged and credited for their contributions to the growth. First, the Baskerville Advisor Manager, Mr. Qmen has been very, very generous in donating keys to my department for our weekly dungeon runs. These dungeon runs have been a very big part of why users are coming and staying in Villoux and Mr. Qmen deserves much credit for helping us maintain them. Also helping with the dungeon runs is the System Press Department, especially the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. Crazycat. Mr. Crazycat has made several forums posts promoting our dungeon runs as we all as our guild. Many users have joined our Discord server through Mr. Crazycat's posts, so I would also like to thank him for his contributions. Finally, I would like to thank the members of the House that have joined our Villoux Guild – the League of Legends Tournament Director, Mr. DeadRusher, the Baskerville Advisor, Mr. ChewOnDiss, and Mr. Crazycat.

While on the topic of the Villoux Guild, I would like to provide an update on it to you. We currently have a total of 22 members in the guild, all of which are also Discord users. Our guild is at the point where can begin doing guild-exclusive dungeon runs, so join the guild while you still can before you start missing out on our exclusive events. Of course, as I've said many times before, we will continue to host public dungeon runs on an almost weekly basis. To keep this up, though, we are in need of some generous users who would be willing to donate keys to our stockpile. If you know of anyone with extra keys or you have some yourself, please speak to me after this evening's meeting.

With all of this good news, I am sorry to spread some bad news, but I feel that I must. For several months now, our private Realm of the Mad God server, Villoux's Realm has been offline due to us lacking the coding expertise to get the server running again. It is great sadness that I announce the decision that my department has chosen to close the server until further notice. When and if we locate someone with the necessary coding skills to bring the server back online, I will fully support re-launching the server, but not until such an individual has been located. Before I end my update, I would like to welcome members of the House to give recommendations as to how they would like to see our dungeon running events improved if anyone has any ideas. I would be open to hearing requests for specific dungeons, having more key pops, or any other recommendations you might have. With that, I will conclude my department update and thank you for your time.

## *League of Legends Update as Read by Mister Hyena*

What's happening, Villoux House of Players? As the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville noted in the system census results, my department is happy to report a stable growth of users over the past few months. For this growth, I would like to thank our System Press Department for doing such a swell job of advertising our monthly tournaments. Taking advantage of our growth, we've been hosting monthly North American tournaments with great success. This past month, we held a 5v5 tournament between two teams. The first game was won by Team Ahri, the second game won by Team Brand, and Team Ahri clenched a victory with their third win. The user, Mr. Blustix1 was named champion of the tournament for his great efforts as a mid-lanner for his team. I would like to thank the members of the House that participated in last month's tournament – the Baskerville Advisor, Mr. ChewOnDiss; the System Press Manager, Mr. Danthemanrs; the Counter Strike Department Chairman, Mr. Dragonride; and, of course, the Villoux Chief of Staff himself, Dr. Baskerville. After mentioning Mr. Dan's name, I would also like to express my deep thanks to him for personally bringing in a total of five users to participate in our tournament. Mr. Blustix1 may have been declared tournament champion, but Mr. Dan was clearly the MVP for the League of Legends and System Press departments.

I hope I've been able to convey how much fun our tournaments are and encourage you to register to participate in future ones. Information about our tournaments is posted in #villoux\_announcements, so please be sure you keep this channel unmuted so that you can stay up-to-date on all happenings in our great system. My department update this meeting will be brief, but, of course, I want to start out by extending my gratitude for those members of the House that have helped establish strong census numbers for our first month back as a department. The System Host, Mr. Hiighlander has been my right-hand man throughout nearly all of our department's processes. Though he is technically only responsible for hosting the servers on his server box, he has made his presence throughout my department much more than that – lending a hand in building, coding, and several other aspects of server development. I would also like to thank the Minecraft Development Board, especially those members of the House that serve on the board – the League of Legends Tournament Director, Mr. DeadRusher; the Baskerville Assistant, Mr. KingKazma; the Baskerville Advisor, Mr. SoulSniper214; the System Coding Manager, Ms. Neonkeii; the Minecraft Server Head, Mr. SargentJ5; the Executive System Art Designer, the honorable Mr. Cronus; the Executive System Coder, Mr. Jdaca; the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. Crazycat; and the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville.

I have, however, had time to hire the first of a new wave of Minecraft Server Heads! Mr. SargentJ5 will be joining our staff as my first Minecraft Server Head. I will conclude by saying that we do plan on releasing a Villoux-beta test for our community survival server in late October. I am currently accepting applications from users to participate in the beta-test, so if you would like to help out with it, please send me a private message. I am looking for some Twitch streamers or YouTubers that have around 50-200 subscribers that make content for these games. I'll take care of working out the details with them, but I would really appreciate it if you guys could send me some channel links of streamers you think would be a good fit for Villoux.

Our Radio Villoux division also has some exciting news to report. Last week, we hosted one of our largest Radio Villoux events in quite a while. We had a total of about 15 users pop in and out of the Radio Villoux voice channel on Villoux's Discord Server. Of those 15, about a third of them sang karaoke for us, including the Radio Villoux DJ, Mr. Skullslice; the Baskerville Advisor, Mr. Steve; the Radio Villoux DJ Manager, Mr. Cheezcake117; the League of Legends Department Chairman, Mister. Hyena; the Executive Baskerville Assistant, Mme. Shortylyons; and the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff himself, Dr. Baskerville! We tried to get the Minecraft Department Chairman, the honorable M. Sullivan to join in on the fun, but maybe next time. Anyway, Radio Villoux is always such a fun time, so I really hope more of you will plan on attending our future events. As a reminder, Radio Villoux is live every Friday night from 8:00 PM – 12:00 AM CST.

Finally, I'll report on our misc. gaming section. We are currently looking to explore incorporating another game into Villoux. After deliberation with Dr. Baskerville, we believe the best type of game we could bring to Villoux would be a server-based game like Minecraft where users need to connect to a specific server to play the game. These types of games allow Villoux to shine above our competition since we are confident that we can provide servers on which excellence is your only option. Some members of the House have already recommended games, such as the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. Fulfi recommending Rust and Dr. Baskerville recommending Team Fortress 2. I'd be open to hearing support for these games, or other games you might think would make a good fit in Villoux.
