Good evening, Villoux House of Players, and thank for you allowing me another opportunity to present a Realm of the Mad God Department update. The first item I would like to note this meeting is that we have a new Realm of the Mad God Guild Master for the Villoux Guild, Mr. Spegetty. Mr. Spegetty previously served as a Baskerville Assistant and I am excited to welcome him to my department's staff as he assists me in managing the Villoux Guild. Mr. Spegetty's primary objectives as Guild Master will be processing membership requests, which I am glad to say are up from last month. The Villoux Guild continues to grow in members and nears closer to reaching the guild's maximum in-game capacity. When and if this happens, I will re-establish the Villoux Elite Guild for the higher-ranking members of the Villoux Guild. In the meantime, I am glad for Mr. Spegetty's assistance in managing the Villoux Guild.

Our department hosted a public dungeon each weekend this month. Attendance at the dungeon runs is up overall, but we are still hosting some dungeon runs without as many users as I would like. The Executive System Press Officer, Mr. Biko and I have been unable to find a System Commercialist to hire to stream the dungeon runs, but we still believe finding such a user would increase participation in the dungeon runs. Chat activity in #rotmg_general has been consistently good throughout this month and I hope we can continue that activity into the next month, especially since I want Realm of the Mad God to retain its status as the system's largest department in next month's system census. Please continue to post about good item drops, character deaths, or just when you want someone to play with. Having an active chat looks good for new members and helps ensure members of our community are staying engaged with one another.

Osu! Update Presented by TheRealPancake

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. For those that do not know me, my name is TheRealPancake and I am very excited to begin serving as your Osu! Department Chairman. I have previously served as the League of Legends Department Chairman since June 2019 but have been playing Osu! for much longer. On behalf of the Osu! Department, the House of Players, and the Grand Council, I would like to thank the former Osu! Department Chairman, Mr. DuXaaa for all of his work as Chairman and assure him I will do my best to further the legacy he has established for our Osu! Department.

Registration has been live for our 4th Osu! tournament for just over a week now. We currently have around fifty applicants, but my staff and I anticipate that number to continue to grow. Registration for the tournament will close next Friday, September 07. My first act as Osu! Department Chairman was to offer the position of Osu! Tournament Master to Mr. P a t r i c k, who has previously served as an Osu! Tournament Director. I believe Mr. P a t r i c k and I will work very well together and look forward to running the tournament alongside him. The Osu! Map Master, Mr. Lefafel will be working with his Osu! Map Poolers to select the maps for the tournament and I am sure the maps will be just as great as last time. The map pool will be released in #osu_announcements on Monday, September 10, just before the tournament is set to begin on Friday, September 14. This should allow all participants about a week to practice the maps before the tournament. Our current goal is to have the tournament concluded by Saturday, October 20, but, of course, that is subject to change depending on how quickly participants are able to play their matches.

The winner of this tournament will receive a profile badge for their Osu! profile, just like last time. I am currently working with the System Art Designer, Mr. Boris_S to design the badge, but since everyone really liked the 3rd Osu! champion’s badge, I believe we will be staying with that design and just changing the number. I believe that is all I wanted to review with you this month, but if you have any questions, comments, or concerns regarding our department or our tournament, I am happy to answer them. League of Legends Update Presented by BrentMar12345

Good day, Villoux House of Players, and thank you for providing me this opportunity to give you a brief update on the League of Legends Department, but, first, please allow me an opportunity to introduce myself. I am BrentMar12345 and I have been serving as a League of Legends Tournament Director for North America for the past several months. I am very excited to be joining you now as the League of Legends Department Chairman, replacing the former League of Legends Department Chairman, Mr. TheRealPancake, who, as you all just saw, has been reassigned to Osu! Department Chairman. With introductions out of the way, let’s dive into our department update.

Our department hosted three tournaments this month; the first being our 2nd North American Teamfight Tactics tournament. This tournament featured a single queue of eight users who three played a best-of-three matches. I would like to thank the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville for serving as the master of ceremonies of this tournament and would like to congratulate the Baskerville Assistant, Mr. Earl554 on being declared tournament champion. The next North American TFT tournament will be held on Saturday, September 07 at 6:00 PM CST. Registration will go live next week, so please check #villoux_announcements or #league_of_legends_announcements for the link. There are no requirements to enter the tournament, so I hope all members of the House will consider registering and playing some games with us.

The second tournament we hosted this month was our 3rd Europe Nordic & East 5v5 tournament. We are still working on increasing the number of users participating in our EUNE tournaments, but this month featured the largest tournament we have hosted thus far, which speaks well for the future of these tournaments. I would like to thank the League of Legends Tournament Master for EUNE, Mr. EG Coli for his work with Mr. Pancake in organizing the tournament and I would like to give congratulations to the winner of the tournament, the Radio Villoux DJ, Mr. Izzy Mizzy. The next EUNE tournament will be held on Saturday, September 14 at 12:00 PM CST, which is 6:00 PM BST. The registration link will be posted in #villoux_announcements and

#league_of_legends_announcements, but please remember your account on EUNE needs to be ranked in order to participate in the tournament.

The third and final tournament we hosted this month was our 46th North American 5v5 tournament. This tournament was smaller than our average tournament size since the tournament coincided with the clash tournament League of Legends was hosting, but we still managed to have a great time. The Executive System Press Officer, Mr. Biko streamed this tournament on Villoux's Twitch account, making it the first official tournament stream sponsored by Villoux. I would like to thank Mr. Biko for streaming the tournament and encourage all members of the House who are not already following Villoux's Twitch channel to go follow it and watch the tournament stream. You can find a link to the channel in #villoux_information. On behalf of the League of Legends Department and this House, I would like to issue congratulations to the winner of our 46th North American 5v5 tournament, the System Press Officer, Mr. Gearbloody and again thank Dr. Baskerville for serving as master of ceremonies for this tournament, too. The next 5v5 North American tournament will be held on Saturday, September 21 at 6:00 PM CST. Like always, the registration link will be posted in #villoux_announcements and #league_of_legends_announcements, but please remember your account on North America needs to be ranked in order to participate in the tournament.

The final note I would like to make is an apology to any member of the House who did not receive a personal invitation to any of our tournaments this month. If you were not sent a direct message by a member of my department's staff, please send me a direct message so I can ensure you are on our contact list, ensure you are messaged in future, and investigate why you were not messaged this month. Again, thank you for the opportunity to present this month's update and I look forward to working with as many of you as possible in hosting our future tournaments.

Team Fortress 2 Update Presented by Headph

Hello everyone and welcome back to your monthly Team Fortress 2 Department update! I have a lot of exciting news to share with you this month, so I hope you are ready! The first note I would like to make is that thanks to a combined effort of the System Coding Manager, Mr. SargentJ5; the Team Fortress 2 Server Head, Mr. Priest of the Ogelord; and me, we have resolved an error in permissions on Villoux's Orange Low-Gravity Crit. Server that was giving the admin tag to all users on the server. Users did not actually have access to admin commands, but the error was embarrassing and misleading, so I am very glad we were able to resolve it. Mr. Ogelord and Mr. Sargent were also able to successfully configure bots on the server! I know many of you have complained about the server not being fun when other users are not connected to it and hopefully bots will help fix this issue. The bots are fully configured to work with low-gravity and crits., and, let me tell you, they certainly know what they are doing. Any initial dismissiveness about playing with bots should be immediately quelled when you get a chance to play against them. My staff and I truly believe the addition of bots to the server is a great step forward to establishing a regular user base and have been having a lot of fun with them ourselves.

On the topic of fun, my department hosted our 26th monthly TF2 tournament yesterday. The tournament was hosted on VOLGCS and just featured a best-of-three style tournament with the general gameplay of low-gravity and crits. I would like to thank Mr. Ogelord; the System Commercialist, Mr. RainyRenRen; and the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. Biko for livestreaming the tournament on Villoux's Twitch channel. I would also like to thank all the members of the House who participated in the tournament and congratulate Mr. Ogelord on being declared tournament champion! This month's tournament was great fun and I hope you are all looking as forward to next month's tournament as I am. With that being said, I hereby conclude my department update and look forward to hearing your thoughts on my department either at today's meeting or while we are playing on VOLGCS!

Minecraft Update Presented by LeYamez

Hello, everyone, and thank you for allowing me this opportunity to address you on this month's activity in our Minecraft Department. The first topic I would like to discuss a fun new addition to our Minecraft server, Villoux Kingdoms, that adds jobs for different classes to complete. The System Coding Manager, Mr. SargentJ5 is still working with me on configuring the plugin, but users will earn a set amount of money each time they perform a task like fishing, slaying mobs, exploring the map, crafting weapons, mining, farming, and more. The available jobs will increase as you level-up in your respective class as you unlock new jobs and rewards. The jobs will be listed on our webpage on Villoux's website under the tabs for the individual classes once we have them determined and I will post an update in #villoux_kingdoms when we have that information available. It is my hope these jobs will address the concerns many of you noted last month regarding an inability to earn money to spend in the commerce class' shops. We will be experimenting with this plugin to see if it properly addresses those concerns as we expect it will, but we still remain open to new ideas about how to earn money if the jobs plugin does not satisfactorily resolve the issue.

On the topic of commerce shops, I am very excited to report I have built a new set of shops for our peddlers, shopkeepers, merchants, and tycoons to use in place of the old shops. These new shops have an open-market concept and provide much more room for our commerce users to sell their wares in. I am also working on building a new arena that will look nicer than our current one. Whereas I like the current arena, I believe the new arena I am working on will prove to be a lot nicer and I am excited to get to share it you sometime next month. The new arena will keep the concept of different biomes divided within the arena but will feature larger biomes with their own unique attributes within them.

Another new attraction for our server is our new 1v1 PVP Minecraft tournament. We hosted the tournament earlier today and I was very pleased with the turnout and the tournament's performance overall. We had about ten users participate in the tournament and the last user standing was the user, Mr. ItzGangsterHD. Congratulations to Mr. ItzGangsterHD for winning the tournament and thanks to all the participants, especially the members of the House who participated! I would also like to thank the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. Biko for livestreaming the tournament on Villoux's Twitch channel. Monthly 1v1 PVP tournaments is something I am interested in exploring, especially due to the good reception we received, so if you have any recommendations for future PVP tournaments, I would love to discuss them with you at this meeting after my update. The Minecraft Ordinance had a new section added to it outlining tournament regulations and proceedings, so please refer to that section if you would like more information. Another tournament we are considered is a building tournament, which was recommended by the Baskerville Advisor Manager, the honorable Mr. Qmen. I would also

appreciate the House's opinion on building tournaments and how you would like to see those implemented.

The final new addition to our server is our new Server Head, Mr. Hibobo210. Mr. Hibobo has been one of the most active and involved users on our server thus far and I am thrilled to begin working with him in his new capacity as Minecraft Server Head. Mr. Hibobo is available to assist you in any day-to-day administrative tasks you may need done like reimbursing you for items lost to lag, helping resolve disputes with other users, and hearing your general concerns and recommendations about the server.

One issue we have been having on the server is users going AFK and macroing to avoid being detected by our AFK auto-kicker. Technically, these macros could fall under the category of using "hacking mods/clients", but my staff and I thought that charge was a bit too severe for macroing. To address this issue, we have instated a new rule that explicitly prohibits macroing and prosecutes users with a one-hour ban in the event they violate the rule. Please be advised the macroing is now officially prohibited on Villoux Kingdoms and be warned you will be punished if you are found to be using it.

I will conclude my department update with reminding the House I would greatly appreciate hearing their opinions on the jobs plugin as a solution to earning money on the server, recommendations for improving our 1v1 PVP tournament, and thoughts on the concept of a building tournament. Thank you very much.

System Press Announcement Presented by Biko

Good evening, everyone. The System Press Department has been very busy this month and I am excited to share with you several exciting updates. I would like to start with noting a few accomplishments in the System Commercialist division of my department. Villoux launched its

own official Twitch channel earlier this month! We plan on streaming the vast majority of Villoux events on the Twitch channel, ranging from Osu!, League of Legends, Team Fortress 2, and Minecraft tournaments to gameplay on our Team Fortress 2 and Minecraft servers. I encourage all members of the House to follow our Twitch channel and support us during each stream to help boost our view count and help us appeal to new users. You can find the link to our Twitch channel in #villoux_information. I have hired two new System Commercialists to help manage our Twitch channel this month: Mr. RocketSamurai, who will be streaming Team Fortress 2 and Mr. RainyRenRen, who will be streaming League of Legends. The channel has already streamed the 46th League of Legends North American 5v5 tournament, the 26th Team Fortress 2 tournament, and the 1st Minecraft PVP tournament, so if you missed any of those streams, you can watch them on the channel now.

The Radio Villoux division of my department has also experienced some exciting new changes. We have introduced a monthly movie night wherein members from across the system come together to watch a movie once a month. The movie is streamed on Kast, which many of you may know bought the popular streaming website Rabbit last month. Users are required to create an account on Kast to watch streams, but account creation is very simple. I select the movies we watch, but I am always very open to input and recommendations from members of the House, so please send me a direct message if you have any requests for this month's movie night. Information about the next movie night will be posted in #villoux_announcements when we have the date set. If you are craving Radio Villoux before our next movie night, do not worry because we will be going live after tonight's meeting for a regular Radio Villoux event. I hope you will all consider joining us in the Radio Villoux voice channel after the meeting.

The Misc. Gaming division of my department has likewise experienced new and exciting changes. We have been sponsoring a Counter Strike, Rocket League, and Terraria section for the past few months, and I am pleased to report we are making progress in getting those sections recognized as departments. The Rocket League section will be hosting its first tournament next month and I hope any of you who play Rocket League will consider joining us for it. The Realm of the Mad God Guild Master, Mr. Spegetty serves as the section leader for Rocket League and will be posting information about tournament registration in the next week or so. The Discord Operator, Mr. Ssibren is the section leader of our Terraria section and he has been hosting events on his Terraria server. Attendance at these events has seen several Villoux users join, but the section still lacks new users who have come to Villoux specifically to play Terraria. I will be working with the Misc. Gaming Section Manager, Mr. Deviationlark and Mr. Ssibren on publishing some forum advertisements for the server next week and hope they will help us in bringing in the new users the section needs to apply for department status. We have also introduced a World of Warcraft section since Mr. Deviationlark noticed many Villouxians have started playing the game again in celebration of the game's classic mode coming back online. The user, Mr. McNaughton will be serving as section leader of World of Warcraft and is currently exploring

either having an already established guild merge into the system or creating a guild just for Villoux. Mr. McNaughton will be posting updates in #world_of_warcraft as they become available, but he is very open to hearing ideas and recommendations any of you may have, so please feel free to send him a direct message if you would like to discuss the World of Warcraft section in Villoux. The Counter Strike section still remains in place, but it is currently without a section leader and is at risk of being removed. If you would like to serve as the section leader of Counter Strike, want more information about section leaders, or have a recommendation for a user to serve as section leader, please send a direct message to Mr. Deviationlark.

Finally, I would like to give a big thanks to our System Press Officers and the System Press Manager, Mr. TunaBoi for doing a great job at up-voting forum advertisements this month. We advertised for Realm of the Mad God dungeon runs and for Villoux Kingdoms. I understand new users joined the system from these posts, so, again, thank you very much to our System Press Officers for the great work they are doing. That concludes this month's System Press Department announcement, but I hope to further conversation with you all at Radio Villoux in just a few minutes.

The new Villoux Operator Bot will add users who have been banned from Villoux's Discord Server to a role called "Banned", which prohibits them from viewing and sending messages to any text channel and prohibits them from viewing and connecting to any voice channel without actually removing them from the server thereby ensuring users who have been banned are able to resume their activity in Villoux as soon as their ban has expired rather than having to be re-invited to the server. The bot also automatically removes the banned role from users once the duration of their ban has expired. If a user leaves the Discord server and rejoins it during their ban, the bot will automatically reassign them to the banned role since it queries their Discord ID as soon as they join the server thereby preventing them any method of circumventing the ban. The Executive Discord Operator, Mr. Wrench and I could not be more pleased with the bot and would like to issue our heartfelt thanks to Mr. IronRain for his work on behalf of the Discord Operation Department.

Speaking of hard-working members of the system, I would like to thank and announce this month's Friend of Villoux. As you know, the Friend of Villoux award is a monthly award given to a member of Villoux's staff that has gone above and beyond in their respective field. It gives me great pleasure to announce this month's Friend of Villoux is the Team Fortress 2 Server Head, Mr. Priest of the Ogelord. Mr. Ogelord devoted many hours this month to working with the Team Fortress 2 Department Chairman, Mr. Headph on configuring bots and fixing permissions on our Team Fortress 2 server, Villoux's Orange Low-Gravity Crit. Server. The Team Fortress 2 Department is certainly indebted to Mr. Ogelord for his unwavering devotion this month.
