Our 4th Osu! tournament was a success and I am very proud of the work my department did in hosting it! I would also like to offer my thanks to the Osu! Map Poolers and the Osu! Tournament Directors for assisting in administrating the tournament, and I would like to give special thanks to the Osu! Map Master, Mr. Lefafel and the Osu! Tournament Master, Mr. P a t r i c k for their extra help in administrating all of the tournament's proceedings.

My department will host Villoux's 5th Osu! tournament in January 2020, but, like all other departments, will be on hiatus until the start of the new year. I am already getting excited for the next tournament and I hope all members of the House who are eligible to participate consider registering themselves at the appropriate time.

Mr. BrentMar will now be serving as a Baskerville Advisor of League of Legends and he says he still open to helping anyone who may have questions about the game, so please feel free to continue reaching out to him for any in-game inquiries.

Now, onto my regular department update. My department hosted our 5th North American Teamfight Tactics tournament on the first weekend of the month. The tournament featured a single queue of eight users who played three best-of-three matches. I am now afforded the awkward pleasure of congratulating myself on being declared tournament champion of the tournament! Though all of our participants were at something of a disadvantage since TFT introduced a new set of champions, origins, and classes this month, we all managed to have a great time. My department also hosted our 48th North American 5v5 tournament this month. This tournament saw two teams of five play three best-of-three matches. Team Ahri was soundly defeated in the first match but came back for the second match. Fortunately for me, though, my team, Team Brand, was able to win the third kingmaking match and my teammate Mr. LaPika was declared tournament champion. This tournament was especially fun because it truly was anyone's game. I would like to thank the Executive Baskerville Assistant, Ms. Peekatchu for her assistance in getting users registered for the tournament. Finally, we also hosted our 4th Europe Nordic and East 5v5 tournament this month. I would like to offer my congratulations to the champion of that tournament, the Misc. Gaming Section Manager, Mr. DuXaaa, and I would also like to thank the EUNE League of Legends Tournament Master, Mr. EG Coli for coordinating the tournament.

As the Osu! Department Chairman, Mr. TheRealPancake just noted, December is referred to as "Villoux's month of rest", so my department will be going on a hiatus next month, but we will be back with our regularly scheduled NA TFT tournaments and our NA and EUNE 5v5 tournaments in January 2020. I am excited to oversee these tournaments as my first official acts as League of Legends Department Chairman and I hope all members of the House who play League will consider joining us on that adventure. I would like to conclude my speech by thanking the Villoux Grand Council for allowing me to begin serving in this new capacity. Thank you all, and I look forward to playing with you in January.

Minecraft Update Presented by Dr. Baskerville

I will be presenting the Minecraft Department update on behalf of the Minecraft Department Chairman, Mr. LeYamez as he is unable to attend today’s meeting due to personal issues. Mr. Yamez asked me to begin by apologizing for his inactivity as of late. Mr. Yamez suffered a serious concussion this month as a result of playing hockey and the concussion has severely limited the amount of time that he is able to spend online. Mr. Yamez on the road to recovery now, though, and has been able to resume working on his department’s latest project – the re-launch of the massively popular drug-themed role-play server Drug Craft. I have been assisting Mr. Yamez in working tirelessly on completing the massive, completely custom hand-built map, and we have started going a bit into overdrive to make-up for lost time. Mr. Yamez still anticipates the server being ready for Villoux beta-testing in January 2020, but that deadline has become a little more fluid now that we are considerably behind schedule due to his concussion. The Grand Council has, however, granted the department exemption from the December Clause of the System Holiday Ordinance, meaning Mr. Yamez and I will be able to continue working on Drug Craft during December. Since all members of staff will find themselves without their normally assigned responsibilities, if any of you find that you would like to offer your assistance in building Drug Craft, please let Mr. Yamez know as he and I would welcome any and all help. You do not have to be a skilled builder for this as there are several small projects that anyone could do, but, of course, we do really appreciate anyone who does have a strong intuition for Minecraft builds. Please send Mr. Yamez a direct message after today’s meeting if you would like to volunteer your time.

Mr. Yamez asked me to conclude his department update by speaking briefly about our other Minecraft server, Villoux Kingdoms. His concussion led to him being unable to coordinate the monthly building and PVP tournaments we generally host, and he is very sorry to any members of the House he may have let down by their absence. Whereas we cannot host these events in December, they will return in January 2020 and Mr. Yamez and I hope you are as excited about them as we are. Mr. Yamez thanks you all for the opportunity to address you, and he looks very forward to welcoming you all to Drug Craft come January.

Hello, Villoux House of Players. I am pleased to present this department update to you on behalf of the Team Fortress 2 Department Chairman, Mr. Dragonride. Over the course of the past month, I have been steadily growing our department's user base by engaging with the larger TF2 community and working on bringing them to Villoux to try our TF2 server, Villoux's Orange Low-Gravity Crit. Server. This has proven to be a successful endeavor as several new users have joined our server as a result of it, so I will continue utilizing this approach in the coming months.

Just like every other department, the Team Fortress 2 Department will go on hiatus during December, but our server will remain online. Since things will be otherwise quiet in Villoux, this would be a great time for any members of the House who have not yet tried the server to give it a go or for any members of the House who have not played TF2 to see whether or not they enjoy playing it. System Press Announcement Presented by Biko

Good evening, everyone. I am addressing you tonight as both your Executive System Press Officer as well as the acting Destiny 2 Department Chairman. The Villoux Grand Council voted to accept the Destiny 2 section's application for department-status at their meeting earlier this evening, but the department was unable to produce a Department Chairman, so the Grand Council has asked that I accept that responsibility in the interim. Let me start by saying how proud I am of this new department for its accomplishments as a section – accomplishments that led to it becoming a department, the only new department to join Villoux in 2019. Thanks is due in large part to the former Destiny 2 section leader, the Minecraft Department Chairman, Mr. LeYamez. Mr. Yamez lit the spark that ignited the fire for this department and our accomplishments would not be possible without his efforts. Now, let me tell you a little bit about the Destiny 2 Department. We will be hosting weekly raids on every Saturday, including Saturdays during December thanks to the Grand Council granting us exemption from the December Clause of the System Holiday Ordinance. We will also be hosting Crucible tournaments once a month, probably on the second Saturday of the month, but that is still to be determined. Villoux also sponsors our own official Destiny 2 clan, the Villoux Guardians Clan. I am excited to announce that the former System Press Officer, Mr. CookieWillnom has been hired as the Villoux Guardians Clan's Destiny 2 Clan Master. Mr. Cookie was integral part of making Destiny 2 a department, so I know his service as Clan Master is paramount to the department's success. Now if all of this information sounds to you like I am speaking a foreign language, don't worry. Destiny 2 can be somewhat complicated at first, but it really is a great game and I would love to help any member of the House that is interested in learning more about it get acquainted with the game.

Now, onto the System Press Department. Radio Villoux hosted its regularly scheduled music night on the second weekend of this month, and we had about six users join us in the Radio Villoux voice channel. We all had a great time listening to music and chatting for over an hour! We also hosted our monthly movie night last night where we screened *Zootopia*. Radio Villoux will go on hiatus during December, but we will be hosting a Christmas song karaoke on Saturday, December 21, 2019. I hope you will join consider joining us for this festive event, especially since many Grand Council Members are known to take the mic. for karaoke.

The System Commercialist division of my department continues to benefit from our partnership with the System Commercialist, Mr. Godson710420. Mr. Godson has been doing a great job at growing our Realm of the Mad God population by streaming our weekly dungeon runs, and I am glad to be ending the year with such a strong System Commercialist.

Finally, I will speak briefly on our Misc. Gaming division. The most important note is that our longtime Misc. Gaming Section Manager, Mr. Deviationlark has retired from his position and

now serves as a System Press Officer. Mr. Deviationlark served in his position as Misc. Gaming Section Manager for over a year and was very helpful to me when I became Executive System Press Officer. Mr. Deviationlark will be missed in that capacity, but I am glad he is remaining on my staff. The former Osu! Tournament Director, Mr. DuXaaa has been hired to replace Mr. Deviationlark as Misc. Gaming Section Manager and I am excited to begin working with him on recruiting new games and users to Villoux come the new year. With the Destiny 2 section's ascension to department, we now only have one section – the Steambirds Alliance section being led by the Baskerville Advisor Manager, the honorable Mr. Qmen. Steambirds Alliance is a game very similar in style and gameplay to Realm of the Mad God, and Mr. Qmen has been promoting the game to any users who enjoy playing Realm. Please feel free to send Mr. Qmen a direct message or chat in #steambirds_alliance if you would like to get involved with the section.

My department will largely be going on hiatus this month, meaning we will not be hosting regularly scheduled Radio Villoux events or implementing new section ideas, so please hold your recommendations until January 2020 when my department and I will be glad to engage with you. Thank you for your time and I hope to see you at our Radio Villoux event directly after today's House meeting.

Discord Operation Announcement Presented by Wrench

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. I am glad to take this opportunity to discuss with you an issue we experienced on our Discord server this month – an invasion of Discord spam bots sending messages advertising a Minecraft server that had nothing to do with Villoux. The bot attacks began on November 08 and ended on November 19. Throughout that time, over one hundred bots joined our Discord server, but, thanks to the effort of many Villouxians, we were rather quickly able to prevent the bots from sending messages. This protection required a major rework of how our Discord server manages permissions, and you may have noticed some of the changes. Firstly, all users on Villoux’s Discord Server have been granted a role called “User”. This role has the same permissions that were previously applied to the “everyone” role and you should not notice any changes in permissions. As a clarification, this role is not indicative of a system staff position; it is assigned to all users. Next, we removed the “Unverified” role that was previously assigned to all new users that joined the server until they verified their account. We removed this role because assigning the role to all new accounts allowed bots to bypass our moderation level restrictions and send direct messages. We elevated the moderation level to the highest level, meaning users must have a verified phone number associated with their account in order to send direct messages unless they have a role on the server. Without the unverified role, all new accounts are sorted into the everyone role, meaning they have no role ergo they are unable to send direct messages. This preventative measure prohibited the bots from sending more spam and we believe they stopped joining the Discord server when they noticed we had outsmarted them.

Several members of staff worked tirelessly to safeguard our Discord server, but I would like to especially thank the Baskerville Advisor, Mr. Phaseout; the Executive System Coder, the honorable Sr. Jibram; the Executive TeamSpeak Operator, the honorable Mr. IronRain; and the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville for their assistance in securing our server. Mr. IronRain in particular went above and beyond as the developer of the Villoux Operator Bot, programming the bot to automatically ban the Discord IDs associated with the spam bots. If it were not for Mr. IronRain’s help, I shudder to think where we would be; probably still under attack. Things have nonetheless returned to normalcy and the spam bot problem should be fully resolved. On behalf of my department and on behalf of Villoux, I apologize for any annoyance these bots may have caused you and appreciate your patience as we addressed the situation. I will now be glad to answer any questions, comments, or concerns you may have regarding my department. Thank you.

Honorable mentions for this month include the System Commercialist, Mr. Godson710420 for his streaming of our Realm of the Mad God dungeon runs and the Team Fortress 2 Server Head, Mr. Priest of the Ogelord for his recruitment efforts.
