Osu! Update Presented by TheRealPancake

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. As I am sure you are aware, Villoux's Osu! Department is currently hosting our 5th Osu! tournament. The round of sixteen is occurring this weekend and the quarterfinals, semi-finals, and finals will be hosted on the following weekends, meaning the tournament is currently scheduled to conclude by Sunday, March 22. I am very pleased to report that the entire tournament has been running exactly on schedule, which is good news for our participants given the several complications that arise when matches and dates are rescheduled.

Regarding the map pool of our 5th tournament, the round of 128 and round of sixty-four map pools respectively received high praise from several tournament participants. I would like to thank the Osu! Map Master, Mr. Lefafel and his Map Poolers for doing a great job at choosing the maps. The round of thirty-two and the round of sixteen map pools, however, have received some very light criticism about map difficulty. Some participants have voiced the opinion that the map pool thus far has been too easy, however, Mr. Lefafel cites the wide variance in skill level in the tournament as the reason that more challenging maps have not yet been included in the pools. Mr. Lefafel has, however, stated that the map difficulty will increase substantially as participants continue to be eliminated to ensure Villoux's tournament is truly testing the skill of our participants. I, therefore, kindly request any participants with reservations about the map pool to simply hang in there until we get to the quarterfinals and beyond. I will conclude discussion about the map pool by restating that the map pools have been very widely praised and that I am very proud of Mr. Lefafel and his staff's work.

As we enter the quarterfinals and beyond, I would like to remind all participants that they will need an Osu! Tournament Director present to refer their match. I encourage them to coordinate with the Osu! Tournament Master, Mr. P a t r i c k to ensure their matches are properly scheduled. Furthermore, my department is currently seeking to hire some additional Osu! Tournament Directors, preferably from participants whom have been eliminated from the tournament. If you or someone you know may be interested in serving as an Osu! Tournament Director, which almost exclusively entails referring matches, please send me a direct message after today's meeting. I would also like to thank Mr. Patrick and his staff for doing a wonderful job at scheduling matches and maintaining our tournament spreadsheet. Mr. Patrick's work has been nothing short of fantastic and my department considers ourselves extremely fortunate to have someone with his skillset in our midst.

Finally, I will conclude my department update by thanking the Executive Discord Operator, Mr. Wrench for implementing pingable roles on our Discord server. This addition has been a great asset to my staff and me. Thank you all for your time and good luck to our participants!

League of Legends Update Presented by xSatanael

Good evening, everyone, and thank you for allowing me the opportunity to address you at today’s House of Players meeting. February has been exciting month for my department, and I am proud to present this month’s department update to you. I will begin by congratulating the Discord Operator, Mr. Thundercloud176 on being declared tournament champion of Villoux’s 7th North American Teamfight Tactics tournament. Our TFT tournaments continue to be a lot of fun for our participants and everyone from novice to expert TFT player enjoy the opportunity to socialize with other Villouxians, so I strongly encourage all members of the House to consider registering for our TFT tournament next month. Registration information and the date of the tournament will be published in #villoux_ announcements in the coming weeks.

Next, I would like to discuss our 5v5 North American tournament. This month marked the 50th North American League of Legends tournament, which is a significant milestone for my department. Villoux began hosting League of Legends tournament in 2012 and it makes me very proud to know that our system continues that tradition eight years and forty-nine tournaments in the future. There was, however, a small incident in our tournament this month with a participant who behaved in an unruly fashion. Unfortunately, when a participant sends combative messages in-game, there is no mechanism for my staff and me to limit their ability to type. The best we can do is recommend all other participants to mute the unruly participant and eject the unruly participant from the tournament after the match has concluded. It is very rare this occurs, however, when it does, I can assure you that my staff and I take it very seriously and seek a swift correction. This is exactly what occurred during our tournament this month and as disqualified the participant who was causing issues and immediately had him replaced for the next round. I would like to offer my thanks to the Baskerville Assistant, Ms. IFeedForIP for helping us quickly find someone to replace the unruly participant. Furthermore, I would like to note that the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville was able to successfully issue a ban against that user from Villoux’s Discord Server for is disruptive behavior. Back to good news, I would like to offer my congratulations to Mr. Biko for being declared tournament champion of our 50th tournament. Mr. Biko is still a relatively new League player, which was evidenced by his KDA, however his team agreed that he fully embodied the qualities of a tournament champion – someone who was a good sport, an inspiration to his team, and demonstrated friendliness and respect to both his teammates and his opponents. On behalf of the League of Legends Department, I offer my sincere congratulations to Mr. Biko for being recognized as tournament champion.

A brief note about our next 5v5 tournament – my staff and I have noticed that tournament registration is always lower when tournaments are hosted on the same weekend as League of Legends’ publisher Riot’s clash tournaments. This has convinced us to do our best to ensure we do not host our 5v5 tournaments on the same weekends of Riot’s clash tournaments. This may lead to a change in tournament scheduling as whereas we have been hosting our 5v5 North American tournaments on the third weekend of the month, we may need to change that to the second or fourth weekend to ensure they are not hosted at the same time as clash. Of course, all information regarding our tournaments will be published in #league_of_legends_announcements and #villoux_announcements, so please keep those text channels unmuted if you are interested in receiving updates about our tournaments. I likewise encourage users interested in our tournaments to add themselves to the League of Legends pings role on Villoux’s Discord Server to ensure you are sent a push notification whenever we make such announcements. A full list of dates for the League of Legends tournaments will be published in #villoux_calendar in the coming days, so please also watch that text channel. That concludes my department update, so I would like to thank you very much for your time and say that I look forward to answering any questions, comments, or concerns that you may have.

Regardless of skill-level, the runs are always a fun opportunity to meet other Villouxians and are a great time to get your membership in the Villoux Guild.

Minecraft Update Presented by Solemn10Gaming

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. My name is Solemn10Gaming and I will be presenting today's Minecraft Department update on behalf of the Minecraft Department Chairman, Mr. Cameron868, who is unable to attend today's meeting due to personal matters. The main item on which I would like to report is the building of our re-launched drug-roleplay server, Drug Craft. The departure of the former Minecraft Department Chairman, Mr. LeYamez set building the server back by quite a bit, so the server will not be open for beta-testing this month as it was anticipated. Instead, our new anticipated date for the launch of Villoux beta-testing is April 2020, though we hope we are able to move that date up. The closed-map server requires an extensive amount of building to help it feel like a proper city, so Mr. Cameron and his staff have been working very hard to achieve that affect. Mr. Cameron asked that I express his thanks to the Minecraft Building Manager, Mr. Stonecraft577 and the Minecraft Builders, Mr. Bobbyethan and Mr. ItzGangsterHD for their contributions to builds on the server. Furthermore, Mr. Cameron would like to offer his sincere thanks to the Villouxians who have volunteered their time to build on the server despite not being members of the Minecraft building staff: the Minecraft Server Head, Mr. Solemn10Gaming; the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. DuXaaa; and the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville. Mr. Cameron is still in need of additional builders, so please send him a direct message if you would be willing to volunteer any of your time to helping get the server online. Please note you can volunteer to build without being reassigned from your current position. Please also note that there are several tasks on the server which require little to no building skill such as placing paths, flowers, and so on, so there is truly work for anyone who would be willing to help. Again, please send a direct message to Mr. Cameron after today's meeting if you would be willing to volunteer your time towards this project. Finally, Mr. Cameron asked that I offer his thanks to the System Coding Manager, Mr. SargentJ5 for working on writing the permissions of Drug Craft.

Now, I would like to briefly speak about our current Minecraft server, Villoux Kingdoms. Villoux Kingdoms remains online and is still available for any users to play on, however, the server is continuing to take second priority to Drug Craft until Drug Craft is released. I still encourage users to explore the server and enjoy the community-based aspect of Minecraft. There was talk of wiping the map, however, we have decided that is not something we are currently interested in doing, so all of your old builds are still on the server waiting for your return. I hope you consider enjoying time on Villoux Kingdoms as you await the arrival of Drug Craft. That concludes the Minecraft Department update for this month. Thank you for your time.

Team Fortress 2 Update Presented by Blehmel the Smol

Good evening, fellow members of the Villoux House of Players. My name is Blehmel the Smol and I am very excited to be joining you as your new Team Fortress 2 Department Chairman. I first joined Villoux at the beginning of January of this year and was shortly thereafter hired to serve as a Baskerville Assistant. In my capacity as an Assistant, I learned a great deal about the innerworkings of Villoux, and, specifically, the Team Fortress 2 Department. I am confident the knowledge I have acquired since that time makes me qualified to serve as Team Fortress 2 Department Chairman and I am very enthusiastic about applying what I have learned to my new position. For the past month, I have been serving as the acting Team Fortress 2 Department Chairman, and I already have several ideas about how to improve my department, however, before I get into that, I would first like to thank the Executive Baskerville Assistant, the honorable Ms. Peekatchu and the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville for mentoring me during my time in the Baskerville Cabinet. I am confident the skills they have helped me develop will prove invaluable during my tenure as a department chairman.

Regarding changes I anticipate implementing, the most significant revolves around our Team Fortress 2 server, Villoux's Orange Low-Gravity Crit. Server or "VOLGCS". We have been experiencing technical difficulties with bringing the server online and we believe the source of these difficulties is the map which the server uses. Whereas we are still investigating this matter, it appears we may need to change the map the server uses in order to bring it back to full functionality. If this is necessary, the new map will still be in the orange map family so as to ensure we do not have to initiate a name change from the server's titular "orange". I will provide more information on this matter as it becomes available to me, but, in the meantime, I would like to thank the Team Fortress 2 Server Head, Mr. Priest of the Ogelord and the Realm of the Mad God Department, Mr. Headph for their assistance in surveying this problem.

Next, I would like to discuss our monthly Team Fortress 2 tournaments. My department has long discussed resuming our monthly TF2 tournaments since our re-establishment, though little headway has ever been made towards that goal. I am completely resolved that this must be a top priority for my department and one of my first acts as Team Fortress 2 Department Chairman is going to be hiring a Team Fortress 2 Tournament Master to assist me in ushering this goal into reality. It is my sincere hope that we host a tournament by the end of next month, though that hinges on my ability to hire a tournament master. I will do everything I can by myself in the meantime, though I know hiring a tournament master is ultimately a necessity, so it is one of my top priorities. I hope to have more information to report to you next month, but that concludes my update for this month. Thank you for your time, and, again, it is truly an honor to be joining you.

Destiny 2 Update Presented by FourLeavedLoser

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. My name is FourLeavedLoser and I serve as a Destiny 2 Raid Director. I am honored to be joining you this evening to present the Destiny 2 Department update on behalf of the newly appointed Destiny 2 Department Chairman, Mr. Dredgen Cinder. Mr. Cinder is unable to join us this evening due to a death in his family, though he is certainly with us in spirit. Before I begin my department update, I would like to introduce you a bit more to Mr. Cinder. Mr. Cinder joined Villoux in January 2020 at the invitation of the Team Fortress 2 Department Chairman, Ms. Blehmel the Smol after Ms. Smol overheard the right honorable Villoux Chief of Staff, Dr. Baskerville express difficulty in hiring a Destiny 2 Department Chairman. Dr. Baskerville was immediately impressed with Mr. Cinder and made him acting Destiny 2 Department Chairman at the beginning of this month and the Villoux Grand Council voted to appoint Mr. Cinder to that position at their meeting earlier today. During his time as acting Destiny 2 Department Chairman, Mr. Cinder also served as the Destiny 2 Clan Master of the Villoux Guardians Clan. To speak more of Mr. Cinder's successes thus far, the Destiny 2 Department hosted its 1st North American Crucible tournament this month. For those unfamiliar, Crucible tournaments in Destiny 2 are PVP tournaments wherein participants battle against one another to earn the most points. This was the first Crucible tournament our department has hosted, but we had a solid number of six participants. I would like to offer my congratulations to the champion of the tournament, Mr. Axel, on a job well done! We will be hosting our 2nd North American Crucible tournament next month and Mr. Cinder will post updates about it in #destiny_2_ announcements. Whereas the tournament is classified as "North American", it is open to registrants from any continent. The North American designation is simply due to the time zone in which the tournaments are hosted. My department is interested in expanding our Crucible tournaments to other continents, such as Europe, once we have enough users from those regions. Nevertheless, I hope you will all consider joining us for our Crucible tournament next month.

The final matter which I would like to briefly discuss is Villoux's official Destiny 2 clan, the Villoux Guardians Clan. Membership in the Villoux Guardians Clan is open to all Villouxians, so I encourage all members of the House to send a direct message to Mr. Cinder asking for an

invitation to the clan. Destiny 2 is a great, free-to-play game, and Mr. Cinder and I would be happy to help anyone interested in learning the ropes of the game. That concludes the Destiny 2 Department update, so I will thank you for your time.

System Press Announcement Presented by DuXaaa

Good evening, everyone. My name is DuXaaa and I am proud to be joining you as your new Executive System Press Officer. I hope that my name is still familiar to many of you as I have previously served on the Grand Council as the Osu! Department Chairman from January 2019 – August 2019. Since then, I have served as an Osu! Tournament Director, and, most recently, as the Misc. Gaming Section Manager. My experience as the Misc. I will post information about the new System Commercialist in #villoux_announcements once we have hired someone.

Finally, with regard to the Misc. Gaming section, upon my promotion to Executive System Press Officer, the position of Misc. Gaming Section Manager is now vacant. I will perform the responsibilities of that office until we hire a new Misc. Gaming Section Manager, but I do not anticipate it will take long to find someone to fill this position. Villoux is currently sponsoring two sections – Dota 2 and Overwatch. The Dota 2 section has already brought seven new users to Villoux, but it is still short of receiving enough support from current Villoux users to apply to become a department. Announcement roles currently exist for the following departments and services: all messages posted in #villoux_announcements; all messages posted in #villoux_calendar; all messages posted in #osu_announcements or in #villoux_announcements about Osu! tournaments and other events, all messages posted in #league_of_legends_announcements or in #villoux_announcements about League of Legends tournaments; all messages posted in #rotmg_general or #villoux_announcements about Realm of the Mad God dungeon runs and news about the Villoux Guild; all announcements posted about Villoux Kingdoms or the Minecraft Department in #villoux_announcements; all announcements posted in #destiny_2_announcements or #villoux_announcements about Destiny 2 raids and Crucible tournaments and news about the Villoux Guardians Clan; and a notification whenever Radio Villoux goes live.

You can view a role menu in #villoux_information and react with the emoji of the department or service for which you would like to receive notifications. The only users who have access to send pingable messages are the respective Grand Council Members responsible for distributing information. Most of these messages will be posted in the respective department's announcements channel or #villoux_announcements but having a reaction role will ensure you are notified of any such messages. You can always remove yourself from any of the roles by removing your reaction to the message. Please do not hesitate to let me know if you need assistance in using the role menu as I am glad to provide any help that I can.
