Transition: We will begin today's meeting with the system census results.

System Census Results Presented by Dr. Baskerville

As I am sure you are all aware, every three months the system holds a system census to survey elements such as the number of users in the system, how diverse the system is in regard to nationalities, and which departments are bringing in the largest amounts of user. The requirements for a user to be defined in the system census, as outlined in the System Census Ordinance in the Villoux Bill of Ordinances, are as follows: "In order for a user to be counted in a department, the user must have been active in Villoux for at least one month prior to the census, must use Villoux's Discord Server or Villoux's TeamSpeak Server, and must not be issued a hiatus or be inactive in the system for excess one month. If a user violates any of the above stated, he/she is ineligible to be counted in the system census." Now that you have a better understanding of the census, I shall proceed with this month's results.

The month of September's results were the best Villoux has ever seen in our ten years of existence. At the time of our last census in May of this year, we had a total 819 active users and we had a total of 667 active users in January 2020. This month, the system has a total of 893 active users, an increase of seventy-five users! This sizeable increase is due in large part to the continued expansion of our Osu! Department; the establishment of the Melty Blood Department; and the robust work of our System Press Department in advertising all of Villoux's services. It is with great excitement I announce Villoux is now larger than ever before!

Specific to each department, the Osu! Department remains the system's largest department with a total of 307 users, an over seventy-user increase from May. Villoux's Osu! tournaments continue to become known on a global scale as one of the most competitive, respectable, and fun tournaments, evidenced by the department's outstanding numbers. The Realm of the Mad God Department remains the system's second largest department with a total of 202 users, a decrease of about twenty users from May 2020. I believe this relatively small decrease in users is due to a waning interest in the game, though the Month of the Mad God event beginning next month will hopefully flesh new life into the game. The League of Legends Department remains Villoux's third largest department with a total of 172 users, which is the exact same number we had in May 2020. The Minecraft Department remains the fourth largest department with a total of forty-eight users, an increase of three users since May. The newly established Melty Blood Department has overtaken the Team Fortress 2 Department as Villoux's fifth largest department, having a total of thirty-four users. This means, of course, that the Team Fortress 2 department has become Villoux's sixth largest and therefore smallest department with a total of thirty-two users, a decrease of two users from May. There is a total of ninety-eight users classified as "non-defined", meaning they belong to no gaming department. This number is up by about fifteen from May. Percentage wise, the Osu! Department accounts for 34% of our total userbase, the Realm of the Mad God

Department accounts for 23%, the League of Legends Department accounts for 19%, the Minecraft Department accounts for 5%, the Metly Blood Department accounts for 4%, the Team Fortress 2 Department accounts for 4%, and 11% of users are non-defined.

The system has a total of 893 users from a total of over seventy different countries around the globe, including every inhabitable continent on Earth. I would like to take this time to recognize these countries by stating their name and the percentage of Villoux they represent: the United States of America – 52%; the State of Canada – 6%; the Russian Federation – 4%; the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Federal Republic of Germany – 3%, respectively; the Commonwealth of Australia, the Republic of Poland, and the Federative Republic of Brazil – 2%, respectively; the Republic of France, the Republic of North Macedonia, the Kingdom of Sweden, the Republic of Chile, the Republic of Estonia, the Republic of Indonesia, the Kingdom of Spain, the Republic of the Philippines, the Republic of Finland, the Republic of Portugal, the People’s Republic of China, the Kingdom of Denmark, the Kingdom of Norway, the Republic of Singapore, the Republic of Czechia, and the Republic of Hong Kong – 1%, respectively; the Republic of Ireland, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of Peru, the Republic of Romania, the Republic of Slovenia, the Republic of China, and the Republic of Tunisia – 0.4%, respectively; the Argentine Republic, the Republic of Austria, the Kingdom of Belgium, the Republic of Hungary, the Republic of Italy, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Malaysia, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, and the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela – 0.3%, respectively; the Republic of El Salvador, the State of Kuwait, the United Mexican States, the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, the Republic of Serbia, the Republic of South Africa, the United Arab Emirates, the Republic of Ukraine, and the Republic of Viet Nam – 0.2%, respectively; and, finally, the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Republic of Colombia, the Republic of Croatia, the Republic of Turkey, the State of Israel, the State of Japan, the Kingdom of Jordan, the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Lebanese Republic, the Republic of Montenegro, the Kingdom of Morocco, the Commonwealth of New Zealand, the Sultanate of Oman, the Kingdom of Nigeria, the State of Qatar, the Republic of Korea, the Swiss Federation, and the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago – 0.1%, respectively.

Before concluding the census results, I would be amiss if I did not thank those members of the House which provided major assistance in recording this month’s census, especially the Executive Discord Operator, Mr. Wrench; the Osu! Department Chairman, Mr. Patrick; the Executive TeamSpeak Operator, the honorable Mr. IronRain; the Melty Blood Department Chairman, Mr. Izzy; the Discord Operative Manager, Mr. Ssibren; and the Discord Operators, Mr. BaitWizard, Mr. Thundercloud176, and Mr. TheRealPancake.

Osu! Update Presented by Patrick

Good evening, everybody. I am very excited to announce that the first round of Villoux's 7th Osu! tournament, the round of 128, began yesterday. We had around 160 registrants, which is the most registrants Villoux has ever had for any tournament hosted by any department! We only have room for 128 participants, though, so the remaining thirty participants were placed on standby in the event some of the original 128 were unable to participate or were disqualified.

The map pool developed by the Osu! Map Master, Mr. Lefafel, and our Osu! Map Poolers has already been receiving acclaim, which is unsurprising given how they never fail to produce a wonderful map pool for our participants. I am very proud of the work of Mr. Lefafel and his staff and would like to thank them for getting our tournament off with a very strong start.

I would likewise wish to thank the Osu! Tournament Master, M. Aidown for doing a great job at coordinating the schedule for the matches and the participant information. I could not have done all of the organizing without M. Aidown, so I am very grateful for his contributions to ensuring the tournament operates smoothly for all of our participants.

The results of the round of 128 have already begun trickling in, but we won't have the final results until tomorrow evening. I will be posting information about the next round, the round of sixty-four, sometime next week, so if you are participating in the tournament, please keep your eyes on #osu_ announcements for that information. Also, if any members of the House are participating, I would like to wish them the very best of luck.

That concludes my department update for now. Again, I would like to thank my amazing staff for doing a great job. I am confident our noticeable growth in the census is due in large part to their work and the quality of tournaments we host. I would also like to thank the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. DuXaaa and the System Press Department for doing a great job at advertising my department, too. With that, though, I will conclude my update and wish you a good evening.

Realm of the Mad God Update Presented by Fulfi

Good evening, Villoux House of Players. I would like to begin my department update this month by discussing some changes in Villoux's two guilds, the Villoux Guild and the Lyllox Guild. When I took over the Realm chairmanship, I decided to remove a number of inactive users from the Villoux Guild, thereby opening slots for more members to join. At this point, we have about twenty slots open in the Villoux Guild and we have about ten users in the Lyllox Guild; therefore, I am going to be working on bringing those in the Lyllox Guild over to the Villoux Guild in an effort to fill that guild up again. As a note, if you are the owner of one of the inactive accounts that was removed from the guild, please either contact me or the Realm of the Mad God Guild Master of the Villoux Guild, Mr. Jedipwner and we will re-invite you to the guild.

As you heard in the census results, my department has over 200 users. It would be ideal if we could get at least half of those people into Villoux-sponsored guilds, so I am going to be making it a priority to contact each user defined in my census and invite them to join the Villoux Guild until it is full again. We will then continue inviting users to join the Lyllox Guild.

I believe the reason my department lost a few users in the census is due in large part to a general disinterest in Realm of the Mad God as a game. The game has stagnated a bit, but it is our hope that next month's Month of the Mad God will boost activity significantly. For those unfamiliar, the Month of the Mad God is an annual event sponsored by Realm's publisher, Decca. Throughout the entire month, there are major content updates and additions, which almost always brings in a large number of new users and encourages old users to return to the game. These new updates should be a great boost to my department.

We are also still looking for a System Commercialist to stream our weekly Realm of the Mad God dungeon runs. We have found that streaming the dungeon runs is probably the most effective means of getting users to join our guilds, so this is a top priority for the Executive System Press Officer, Mr. DuXaaa and me. Whereas we have reached out to several potential Commercialists, we have as of yet been able to find one that we can work with; therefore, if you have any recommendations for someone who streams Realm on Twitch, please let either Mr. DuXaaa or me know.

I will conclude my department update by thanking you for your time and wishing you all a happy Month of the Mad God.

It has truly been an honor and a pleasure for me to serve as the League of Legends Department Chairman, and I would like to thank the House and the Grand Council for granting me that opportunity.

Moving on to regular business, Villoux was scheduled to host our 14th North American Teamfight Tactics this month; however, we canceled it due to low attendance. I was very disappointed to make this decision, but I assume everyone is currently busy adopting to new school schedules. It is my hope that we instead host our 14th tournament on next Saturday, October 03 at 6:00 PM CST.

Our 7th North American 1v1 tournament was held on the second weekend of the month, and it had decent attendance. I would like to offer my congratulations to the Baskerville Advisor, Mr. BrentMar123 on being declared tournament champion after defeating all other participants. Mr. BrentMar’s title of Advisor of League of Legends is clearly well-deserved as he did a spectacular job in each of his matches.

Our 56th North American 5v5 tournament saw two teams of five users competing against each other. Everyone who participated in the tournament had a great time meeting new users and making new queue partners, which made me very glad. I would like to offer my congratulations to the user, Mr. Lilÿ for being declared tournament champion. He played fantastically in each game and is very deserving of the recognition.

Well, that concludes my department update for this month. I would like to conclude my update by again thanking Villoux for giving us the opportunity to host a Melty Blood. If our first two months in the system are any indication, the department will be a very promising one and I am excited to lead it into the future. Thank you.

In the interim chairmanships in both departments, the respective departments' members of staff have stepped up to ensure the departments remain in operation, and I would like to thank them for doing so, especially the System Coding Manager, Mr. SargentJ5 and the Baskerville Advisor Manager, the honorable Mr. Qmen.

Speaking of hard-working members of the system, I would like to thank and announce this month's Friend of Villoux. As you know, the Friend of Villoux award is a monthly award given to a member of Villoux's staff that has gone above and beyond in their respective field.
