

*In Honor of Mr. Fulfi*

One my favorite parts of serving as Villoux Chief of Staff is nominating the most deserving members of our system to be recognized by the Grand Council with honor, and I am excited to be making the recommendation of a worthy candidate this evening, the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. Fulfi. Mr. Fulfi began serving as Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman exactly one year ago in June 2018 after I had pleaded with him for several months to consider accepting the position. Mr. Fulfi left a wonderful impression on me with his performance as the Realm of the Mad God Guild Master of the Nyan Eats Guild from April 2017 – May 2017, Guild Master of the AxW Guild from May 2017 – June 2017, and Guild Master of the Luv is Rage Guild from June 2017 – July 2017. Mr. Fulfi jumped between these three guilds as Villoux members moved between them thereby ensuring Villoux was not losing users by them leaving our guilds; rather, we kept all of the members by incorporating their new guilds into the system. This unwavering loyalty to the system immediately identified him to me as someone whom the system could not afford to not have representing the department in a higher administrative capacity, so in May 2018 I offered him the position of Baskerville Advisor of Realm of the Mad God and, of course, this led to his ascension to Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman in June 2018.

Villoux's Discord Server had not yet existed for a full year when Mr. Fulfi became Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman and was still struggling to find a way to restore the users in the department we had lost from the transition from TeamSpeak to Discord. Mr. Fulfi was paramount in deciding how the Realm Department would be administrated on Discord and modernizing the methods we used on Villoux's TeamSpeak Server to be applicable on Villoux's Discord Server. Mr. Fulfi introduced the first Realm of the Mad God guild exclusively created for the purpose of servicing Villoux users, the Villoux Guild. He subsequently served as Guild Master of the Villoux Guild from September 2018 – October 2018 and has served as acting Guild Master each time the Guild Master position has been vacant since then. His idea of a Villoux-exclusive

guild eliminated the system's need to compete with bringing other guilds to join Villoux's Discord Server since most other guilds offered their own Discord server. This solution is what saved our Realm of the Mad God Department from closure after months of failing to recruit new guilds to the system. When the Villoux Guild's membership capacity was reached, Mr. Fulfi moved to create the Villoux Elite Guild to ensure every user in his department whom wished to hold membership in a Villoux-sponsored guild was eligible to do so. Mr. Fulfi served as the Guild Master of the Villoux Elite Guild from February 2019 – May 2019 when the guild was disbanded since the Villoux Guild's membership decreased below maximum capacity. As Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, Mr. Fulfi has attended 11 Grand Council meetings, 11 House of Players meetings, and 45 weekly meetings with me; he has been served by 4 Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters and 3 Realm of the Mad God Dungeon Masters.

Mr. Fulfi has also battled several personal issues during his tenure as Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, including the failing health of his father, the death of grandmother, and the ensuing financial instability. Despite these major and dramatic disturbances in his personal life, he ensured that our Realm of the Mad God Department did not suffer because of his personal tragedies. This again speaks to the devotion and loyalty Mr. Fulfi has expressed to our system throughout his entire tenure as a Grand Council Member. In my opinion, Mr. Fulfi, undoubtedly embodies all of the qualities our Grand Council should seek to consider when awarding members with the highest honor our system has to offer, which is why I move for the Grand Council to bestow honor to one of the most resilient, tenacious, loyal, and devoted users they have ever had the privilege to consider their peer.
