

League of Legends Ordinance

This Ordinance States:

Effective April 2012

This ordinance hereby establishes League of Legends as one of the Villoux Server System's official gaming departments. This ordinance does not fully cover all material listed in the System Staff Ordinance or the Unity Ordinance, which also heavily govern the League of Legends Department's administration, so it is recommended League of Legends senior staff also familiarize themselves with those ordinances as well, though this is not recommended for other staff or users. This ordinance is also not completely reflective of all other ordinances within the Villoux Bill of Ordinances which may also hold some governance over this department.

Section 1 - General Information

Cronus Clause

Effective August 2017

Villoux's Discord Server will be the primary base of communications for all activity within Villoux's League of Legends Department. The text channel #league_of_legends under the League of Legends category will be used for general conversation about the game and department announcements. Each region sponsored by the system will be granted a voice channel, which can be used by any users who wish to discuss League of Legends verbally. It is the responsibility of the Discord Operation Department to ensure peacefulness and order within the League of Legends category on Discord. All other information regarding Villoux's Discord Server can be found in the Discord Ordinance.

Normerra Clause

Effective September 2012

The Villoux Server System uses United States Central Standard Time (CST) as its official time zone, pursuant to the Fredrik Clause of the Unity Ordinance. All League of Legends tournaments shall, therefore, operate in USCT regardless of their region.

Penguin Clause

Effective August 2013

The League of Legends Department Chairman may create a “Villoux Select Team” for the League of Legends Department consisting of a team of five Villoux users who are exemplary at playing League of Legends. The Villoux Select Team may enter tournaments against other communities as representatives of the Villoux Server System. It should be noted being a member of the Villoux Select Team is an honorary position and is therefore not equitable to a system staff position.

Pabu Clause

Effective March 2016

Nordic and Eastern Europe by extension of Riot Games’ Europe Nordic and Eastern League of Legends server shall be officially sponsored by Villoux’s League of Legends Department. This region may be abbreviated as “EUNE” or “Europe Nordic & East”.

Madison Clause

Effective September 2012

North America by extension of Riot Games’ North American League of Legends server shall be officially sponsored by Villoux’s League of Legends Department. This region may be abbreviated as “NA”.

xSatanael Clause

Effective January 2020

The League of Legends Department will sponsor a club on the North American League of Legends server named “The Villoux Server System”. This club is open to any NA members of the department. The League of Legends Department Chairman is ultimately responsible for the administration of this club unless the League of Legends Department Chairman does not own an NA account. The League of Legends Tournament Master of North America becomes responsible in the event the League of Legends Department Chairman is unable to fulfill this responsibility. It should be noted that there were two previously officially sponsored clubs, “Villoux” and “Villoux

Server System”, but these clubs are now defunct. The Villoux Chief of Staff and the deputy Chief of Staff should have administrator privileges in the club alongside the League of Legends Department Chairman and the League of Legends Tournament Master of North America.

Section 2 - Staff Structure

SoulSniper214 Clause

Effective September 2012

The Villoux League of Legends Department is ultimately governed by the Villoux Grand Council. The Grand Council shall appoint a League of Legends Department Chairman to oversee the operations within the League of Legends Department. The League of Legends Department Chairman shall appoint and demote League of Legends Department staff members as appropriate. It is the responsibility of the League of Legends Department Chairman to fulfill the responsibilities of any vacant positions within the League of Legends Department.

Rpascoal Clause

Effective April 2016

The League of Legends Department Chairman may appoint one League of Legends Tournament Master for each region supported by the League of Legends Department. League of Legends Tournament Masters aid in the administration and hosting of Villoux’s monthly League of Legends tournaments. League of Legends Tournament Masters are often the master of ceremonies for their respective region’s tournaments.

DHG Arthas Clause

Effective September 2012

League of Legends Tournament Masters may hire up to five League of Legends Tournament Directors for their respective region. League of Legends Tournament Directors aid in helping and encouraging users to register for their region’s respective tournaments and should be expected to

bring at least five participants per tournament. League of Legends Tournament Directors are often the team captains in League of Legends tournaments.

Section 3 - General Tournament Proceedings

InstaPwn Clause

Effective September 2012

The League of Legends Department will host a tournament each month for regions supported by the department. These tournaments are 5v5 de facto. The tournaments are an opportunity for members of Villoux's League of Legends Department to get to know one another and have a fun time in a match. The tournaments should be perceived as casual yet professional and should therefore not be taken over competitively. Registration for the tournaments are done at an individual level rather than a team level, though users may make unofficial and informal requests to play with other tournament participants. The individual responsible for the operation of the tournament shall be known as the "master of ceremonies"; this is generally a League of Legends Tournament Master, the League of Legends Department Chairman, or the Villoux Chief of Staff.

April Clause

Effective September 2012

The League of Legends Department Chairman will decide how many teams will participate in the tournament depending on the number of users registered for the tournament. If only five users are registered, they will queue with one another to play against another random League of Legends team from outside of Villoux. If ten users are registered, the two teams will play best-of-three matches. The two teams shall be named Team Ahri and Team Brand, respectively. If fifteen users are registered, the first team will play against the second team, then the first team will then play against the third team, and then the second team will play against the third team. The third team shall be named Team Cassiopeia and the first two teams shall carry the names Team Ahri and Team Brand. The winning team in each match will then play against one another and the team that wins that match will win the tournament. If twenty users are registered, four teams will play against one another; the first three teams will carry the names Team Ahri, Team Brand, and Team Cassiopeia, and the fourth

team shall be named Team Darius. Team Ahri will play against Team Brand while Team Cassiopeia plays against Team Darius. Team Ahri will then play against Team Cassiopeia while Team Brand plays against Team Darius. Finally, Team Ahri will play against Team Darius while Team Brand plays against Team Cassiopeia. Whichever team has the highest number of wins will win the tournament, making the total number of matches three per team. In the event two teams have the same number of wins, they will play against each other and the winner of that match will win the tournament. This trend can be continued for teams of twenty-five or higher. The League of Legends Department Chairman will cut-off registration with the last user to register in an increment of five and apologize to the remaining users registered and explain they have been cut from the tournament due to lack of registration.

Fredrik Clause

Effective April 2017

Tournament participants will register for the tournament on a Google Forms form. The Villoux Chief of Staff will remain the owner of all tournament-related Google Forms but will grant the League of Legends Department collaborator access to the Google Forms. Respective League of Legends Tournament Masters may also be granted access to the Google Forms at the request of the League of Legends Department Chairman. The form should ask the registrant's Villoux system-defined name, Summoner name, lane preference, and current rank. The form should also contain acknowledgements that the tournaments will be hosted on Villoux's Discord Server, therefore requiring access to Discord and audio communication, and acknowledgements that failing to attend the tournament after registration will result in a Discord ban for "Truancy", pursuant to the Wrench Clause of the Discord Ordinance.

ChewOnDiss Clause

Effective September 2017

The master of ceremonies is to post the team roster in #league_of_legends on Villoux's Discord Server half an hour prior to the start time of the tournament. The team roster should include participants' assigned team, role, rank, and indication of each team's captain.

Zickerly Clause

Effective September 2012

Each team in the tournament will have a designated “team captain”. This is an honorary title that carries no weight aside from being their respective team’s liaison with tournament direction staff. Team captains will also be the individuals responsible for banning champions and maintain the right to first-pick on their respective teams. Team captains are also responsible for ensuring each member of their respective team is in the tournament lobby.

Phil Clause

Effective September 2012

Each team will be granted a private voice channel on Villoux’s Discord Server to use for communication during the lapse of the tournament. This private channel can be a specially created private channel, unoccupied team channels, or other staff channels. The team captain is responsible for ensuring each member of their respective team is able to access the voice channel. Tournament participants are required to be present in their team’s voice channel and may not verbally communicate with any of their opposing teams during the tournament.

Dr. Baskerville Clause

Effective September 2012

The master of ceremonies will read an opening speech to explain all of the tournament’s rules and proceedings prior to the division of teams into locked channels. The tournament master will read a closing speech congratulating the tournament champion, thanking participants for playing in the tournament, and encouraging registration at future tournaments at the conclusion of the tournament.

Jibram Clause

Effective April 2019

Team Captains may request the master of ceremonies perform a single coin flip to determine which team will be playing on which side. The result of the master of ceremonies’ coin flip is binding for the first match and will be continually conversed for all subsequent matches between the same two teams.

Suffy Clause

Effective September 2012

The master of ceremonies will create a custom lobby in League of Legends to host the tournament., The master of ceremonies will designate one of the respective team captains as responsible for the creation of the lobby in the event the he or she is not participating in one of the tournament matches. The lobby's name should resemble "Villoux League of Legends tournament". The map should be Summoner's Rift, the team size should be set at five, the game type should be tournament draft mode, and spectators should be allowed. There should not be a password for the lobby as users that join the lobby not officially participating in that specific match should be kicked by the lobby's owner.

Danthemanrs Clause

Effective April 2019

The master of ceremonies must re-create the lobby under the same parameters outlined in the Suffy Clause in the event a user leaves the tournament lobby prior to the match's start. All participants who banned and selected champions prior to the first lobby's disbandment must ban and select the exact same champions they banned in the first lobby.

MosheTDD Clause

Effective May 2019

The master of ceremonies maintains the right to make changes to the team rosters in the event a user leaves or is removed from a tournament between matches, including changing a participant's team and role.

SnoZzy Clause

Effective September 2012

The League of Legends Department staff will meet in the Department Chairman's private voice channel once a winning team has been determined to discuss whom they feel should be named "tournament champion". This is an honorary title that does no bestow any additional rights to the recognized user. The tournament champion will be a user the League of Legends Department staff

feel contributed greatly to their team, served as a good leader or example to other users, and was skilled at their respective lane. The tournament champion is not required to come from the winning team. In addition to being congratulated in the tournament's closing speech, the user should be recognized in #villoux_announcements on Villoux's Discord Server, under the League of Legends Department's history on Villoux's website, and at the subsequent Villoux House of Players meeting in the League of Legends Department update.

Flosion Clause

Effective August 2015

The League of Legends Department Chairman maintains the right to bestow a prize to the tournament champion in the form of a mystery gift, skin, or Riot Points, though this is not customary. The League of Legends Department Chairman may use his or her own personal funds to award the prize or may request an allowance from the Villoux Grand Council to cover the cost of the prize. It should be noted it is discouraged to award prizes as it creates an undesired competitive atmosphere in the tournament.

BrentMar123 Clause

Effective March 2019

System Commercialists may stream Villoux's League of Legends tournament's gameplay with the consent of the League of Legends Department Chairman and the Executive System Press Officer but must receive consent from all users whose voices would appear on the stream in order to stream the audio of the tournament. A user who is not a System Commercialist must receive permission from the League of Legends Department Chairman, the Villoux Chief of Staff, and all users whose voices would appear on the stream in order to stream a tournament.

Section 4 - Special Tournament Proceedings

Herc Clause

Effective June 2013

The League of Legends Department Chairman may choose to host a 1v1 League of Legends tournament in addition to the regularly scheduled 5v5 tournament. 1v1 tournaments require an even number of participants whom will be randomly paired off into 1v1 matches. The winner of each 1v1 match will then go on to face the winner of another 1v1 match and this trend shall continue until one singular user emerges victorious over the other users. In a 1v1 tournament, matches should be played in a custom game on the Howling Abyss map with a team size of one and use the tournament draft game mode. Spectators must be allowed as League of Legends Department staff must referee the matches to confirm they are following Villoux regulations. All normal tournament proceedings apply to 1v1 tournaments.

TheRealPancake Clause

Effective July 2019

The League of Legends Department Chairman may choose to host a Team Fight Tactics League of Legends tournament in addition to the regularly scheduled 5v5 tournament. TFT tournament registration will be limited to derivatives of eight users, e.g. a tournament may consist of eight, sixteen, twenty-four users, etc. but may not consist of five, ten, or twenty users. TFT tournament registration operates on a first-come first-serve basis, meaning any users whom register after a derivative of eight has been reached without achieving another derivative of eight will be denied the ability to participate in the tournament but may be used as substitutes. In an 8-user tournament, one queue will play three matches and the user with the highest cumulative score will be declared tournament champion. In a 16-user tournament, all participants will play the first match. The top four users in queue A's first match will play a second match against the top four users in queue B's first match and the winner of the second match will be declared tournament champion. In a 24-user tournament, all participants will play the first match. The top three users in queue A's and queue B's first matches and the top two users from queue C's first match will play a second match and the winner of the second match will be declared tournament champion. Tournaments with multiple queues will have

their queues randomly selected by the League of Legends Department staff. All normal tournament proceedings apply to TFT tournaments.

Section 5 - Tournament Rules

KingKazma Clause

Effective May 2019

Tournament participants are not allowed to have another user login to their League of Legends account to play matches on their behalf. Both the user who gave access to their account and the user who played on the account risk being department banned from the League of Legends Department and the user who gave access to their account will be issued a ban from Villoux's Discord Server for "Truancy", pursuant to the Wrench Clause of the Discord Ordinance.

Viper Mk II Clause

Effective January 2014

Tournament participants are not allowed to deviate from their assigned role in the tournament as changing roles is strictly prohibited. Teams who do not play their assigned roles will automatically lose the match in which they played the wrong roles.

Pwnzy Clause

Effective October 2015

The items in this clause constitute the tournament's rules. The following actions are expressly prohibited in Villoux League of Legends tournaments:

- (1) Intentionally feeding - intentionally allowing the enemy team to slay your champion
- (2) Rage quitting or going AFK - leaving the game or your keyboard for a prolonged period of time
- (3) Not putting forth a reasonable amount of effort - obviously giving-up or not taking the tournament seriously
- (4) Flaming - excessively insulting other users, either via in-game chat or on Discord

Users found violating this clause may be subject to bans from Villoux's Discord Server and/or department bans from the League of Legends Department.

Blustix1 Clause

Effective May 2019

Team captains may choose to target ban a specific participant on the enemy team without fear of being in violation of any tournament regulations.

Dragonride Clause

Effective November 2013

Tournaments may be paused up to three minutes if a user disconnects from the game or must immediately leave their computer for a brief period of time. The game will continue with or without the absent user once three minutes have expired, though the user may be subject to punishment should they not return within the allotted time. This three-minute pause is allotted to each user at an individual level rather than at a team level.

VClip Clause

Effective July 2019

Tournament participants are strictly prohibited from communicating information to enemy teams. Users found in violation of this rule may be issued a ban on Villoux's Discord Server for "Distribution of Private Information" and banned from participating in future tournaments.

Peekatchu Clause

Effective May 2019

Teams may choose to surrender a match if they feel as if a loss is inevitable. Surrender votes may only be held after the first fifteen minutes of the game. Surrender votes prior to the first twenty minutes of the game will require unanimous team consent to pass whereas surrender votes subsequent to first twenty minutes only requires three-fifth's team consent to pass.

xXDeathWish159Xx Clause

Effective July 2019

Users who become verbally disruptive during a tournament will be banned from Villoux's Discord Server, muted by all users in-game, and potentially banned from participating in future tournaments.

Section 6 - Tournament Punishments & Bans

Flogknw Clause

Effective April 2019

Users who register for a tournament and fail to attend said tournament will be issued a one-hour ban on Villoux's Discord Server for "Truancy", pursuant to the Wrench Clause of the Discord Ordinance.

Snow Clause

Effective March 2016

Users who are routinely absent from League of Legends tournaments after registering for said tournaments may be banned from participating in future tournaments. It is recommended once a user totals three absences said user is banned from participating in future tournaments.

Purehearts Clause

Effective September 2017

Users who are issued a ban from Villoux's Discord Server during the time at which a tournament for which they have registered is occurring will be counted as absent from the tournament.

Bloodfreya Clause

Effective January 2013

Users who have been issued department bans in the League of Legends Department are ineligible to participate in any Villoux League of Legends tournament. Details concerning department bans are outlined in the Joepr9 Clause of the Discord Ordinance.
