

Misc. Gaming Ordinance

This Ordinance States

Effective April 2015

This ordinance hereby designates the Misc. Gaming division of the System Press Department as the grounds from which games apply to become recognized as departments within the Villoux Server System. The Misc. Gaming Section will be granted a category on Villoux's Discord Server with one general text channel and one general voice channel. Games which users wish to become departments will first be referred to as "sections" and are led by a "section leader", an honorary position which yields no actual administrative authority and does not reflect a system staff position. Sections which meet the requirements set forth by this ordinance will apply themselves to the Villoux Grand Council at their next regularly scheduled meeting wherein the Grand Council will determine whether or not to accept the section's application as a department or disband the section. The Grand Council must vote 50% "In Favor" in order for the section to ascend to department status.

Section 1 - Game Eligibility

Bosiephus Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections may only exist for games which meet the following criteria:

- 1) The game must be an online multiplayer game, meaning the game must be downloaded able to computers or be browser-based. The game can be accessible by other consoles as long as it has a computer version. The game is not required to be free-to-play.
- 2) The game may not include excessive amounts of inappropriate content such as vulgarity, pornography, racism, and sexism. Refer to the Zedl Clause, the Kirinae Windstalker Clause, the Spree Clause, and the Icyx Clause of the Discord Ordinance for more information on Villoux's definitions of the aforementioned.
- 3) The game must be in either a full-release or a stable beta release.

- 4) The game must allow for the creation of servers, guilds, or tournaments with a minimum of ten users. Games which offer servers must have their section offer a server and games which offer guilds must have their section offer a guild.

Cronus Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections may not exist for games already sponsored as departments within Villoux; however, sections may exist for games which were previously sponsored by Villoux but had their department disbanded.

Section 2 - Section Requirements

Deviationlark Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections may not exist indefinitely, may not exist without intention to become a department, and may not exist if they do not meet the game requirements outlined by this ordinance. The Executive System Press Officer upon the advice of the Misc. Gaming Section Manager will determine whether or not sections are maintaining Villoux standards.

Dr. Baskerville Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections must exist for a minimum of one month before applying to the Grand Council, regardless of all other requirements being met. The section must maintain all section requirements during this one-month period.

Botmfeeder Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections must meet user requirements in order to apply for department status. The section is required to have the support of at least ten Villoux users and bring at least ten new users to Villoux's Discord Server. New users who join and then leave the Discord server will not be counted nor will

new users be counted towards the number of Villoux users. The ten Villouxians who support the section must demonstrate their support by either playing the section's game at least once in the thirty-days prior to its department application or by not playing the game and merely expressing to the Misc. Gaming Section Manager that they believe the section would make a good department. It is the responsibility of section leaders to report user activity to the Misc. Gaming Section Manager.

Metz Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections must host at least one server, guild, or tournament with a minimum of ten users prior to applying for department status. Servers and guilds must exist with regular traffic of five users per day in addition to the total number users. Sections are welcome to offer a combination of servers, guild, and tournaments if they so desire and are enabled to do so by their games.

FXZMAN Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections which do not demonstrate noticeable signs of progression towards meeting the requirements to apply for department status will be disbanded. The same game may not be sponsored by another section until thirty-days after the game's latest section was disbanded.

Section 3 - Sections & the System

Booksmn Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections do not maintain the right to access any of Villoux's resources, including system hosts, system funds, and assistance from system staff. Section leaders are expected to construct their own support network to help them achieve department status.

Spazproof Clause

Effective April 2015

The Executive System Press Officer and the Villoux Grand Council maintain the right to require the Misc. Gaming Section Manager to sponsor a section in the event it appears such a section would benefit the system. These sections will follow all other guidelines outlined in this ordinance but do maintain the right to access the system's resources, thereby exempting them from the Booksman Clause of this ordinance.

Flosion Clause

Effective April 2015

The Villoux Grand Council maintains the right to grant exemption from meeting the requirements outlined in this ordinance. 50% of the Grand Council must vote "In Favor" of such a proposal in order for it to pass.

Crokey Clause

Effective April 2015

Sections must strive to maintain their successful standards as a section if they are promoted to department status. Failure to maintain said standards may result in the Villoux Grand Council disbanding the department.

Section 4 - Staff Structure

Zaaeen Clause

Effective April 2015

Section leaders and users who aide section leaders are not recognized as system staff members and are therefore not granted permissions, roles, or user private voice channels on Villoux's Discord Server; allowed to attend House of Players meeting; or any other system staff benefits. System staff members are therefore eligible to serve as section leaders since the position is considered honorary. System staff members serving as section leaders do not forfeit any of their rights as system staff members and are still expected to fulfill the staff responsibilities. Section leaders report directly to the Misc. Gaming Section Manager.

April Clause

Effective March 2018

The Misc. Gaming Section is a section of Villoux's System Press Department and is therefore directly administrated by the Executive System Press Officer. The Executive System Press Officer may appoint a Misc. Gaming Section Manager to aid in the administration of the Misc. Gaming Section. The Misc. Gaming Section Manager is responsible for accepting and rejecting proposed sections, weekly meetings with each section leader to provide guidance and receive reports, and weekly meetings with the Executive System Press Officer to report on the progress of sections. The Executive System Press Officer is responsible for these duties in the event there is no Misc. Gaming Section Manager.

ShadowBoo Clause

Effective April 2015

The Executive System Press Officer and the Misc. Gaming Section Manager maintain the right to remove section leaders from their honorary position if said section leaders have demonstrated they are unfit to serve as a section leader. The user replacing the previous section leader should be given access to everything to which the previous section leader had access and is not required to restart any time-sensitive requirements, e.g. five users per day on a server for a regular interval.
