

Realm of the Mad God Ordinance

This Ordinance States:

Effective March 2012

This ordinance hereby establishes Realm of the Mad God as one of the Villoux Server System's official gaming departments. This ordinance does not fully cover all material listed in the System Staff Ordinance or the Unity Ordinance, which also heavily governs the Realm of the Mad God Department's administration, so it is recommended Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters also familiarize themselves with those ordinances as well, though this is not recommended for other staff or users. This ordinance is also not completely reflective of all other ordinances within the Villoux Bill of Ordinances that may also hold some governance over this department. The Villoux Chief of Staff is the ultimate enforcer of all ordinances within the Villoux Bill of Ordinances, but the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman is directly responsible for the enforcement of this ordinance within the Realm of the Mad God Department.

Section 1 - General Information

Coolkidss Clause

Effective March 2012

Users are not expressly prohibited from using hacked in-game clients or utilizing exploitations, though the Villoux Server System actively discourages this behavior. Users who distribute hacked clients or explain how to utilize exploits risk being charged with "Distribution of Hacking Mods/Clients", pursuant to the Cnx4mia123 Clause of the Discord Ordinance.

SwatSec Clause

Effective September 2013

Users who hack Realm of the Mad God itself risk being considered a major threat to the system, the system's reputation, and its users, and may therefore be subject to a system ban trial for "Treason" depending on the severity of the hack.

Mr Pineapple Clause

Effective April 2012

Users who prove they consistently violate the Realm of the Mad God Ordinance may be issued a department ban by the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman or the Villoux Grand Council, pursuant to the Joepr9 Clause of the Unity Ordinance. A department ban is a complete ban of the user from all of Villoux's Realm of the Mad God servers, all Villoux Realm of the Mad God guilds, any events sponsored by the Realm of the Mad God Department, and all channels within the Realm of the Mad God category on Villoux's Discord Server.

MPGH Clause

Effective March 2012

The Villoux Server System defines a "system ban" as the most severe punishment the system can issue against a user, pursuant to the 101Blasphemy101 Clause of the Unity Ordinance. A system ban is a permanent ban from all Villoux owned or operated servers, groups, tournaments, websites, and other entities. System banned users are therefore strictly prohibited from connecting to any Realm of the Mad God server, guild, or event. Server staff should issue a permanent ban against any system banned user who manages to connect to a Villoux Realm of the Mad God server for the reason "Ban Evading" and guild staff should evict system banned users who manage to join the guild. The Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, the Villoux Chief of Staff or a Villoux Grand Council Member should be immediately notified in this event. It is the responsibility of the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman to ensure that a system ban list is in effect across all Villoux Realm of the Mad God servers, guilds, and events.

Zaaeen Clause

Effective March 2012

Users may appeal a private server ban by submitting a ban appeal to the respective Realm of the Mad God server's Realm of the Mad God Server Head. This appeal should outline how the user plans on changing if allowed to return to the server and include an apology for their past transgressions. Department bans may be appealed using the same criteria to send an appeal to the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman. System Bans may appealed using the same criteria

to send an appeal to the Villoux Grand Council. Realm of the Mad God Server Heads do not have authority to appeal department bans and neither Realm of the Mad God Server Heads nor the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman have authority to appeal a system ban.

Section 2 - Staff Structure

Dr. Baskerville Clause

Effective August 2018

The Villoux Realm of the Mad God Department is ultimately governed by the Villoux Grand Council. The Grand Council shall appoint a Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman to oversee the operations within the Realm of the Mad God Department and the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman shall appoint one Realm of the Mad God Guild Master to each Realm of the Mad God Guild sponsored by the Villoux Server System. Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters shall appoint staff to aid in the administration of their respective guild, but these guild staff members are not considered members of the system's staff. The Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman shall appoint one Realm of the Mad God Server Head to each Realm of the Mad God private server sponsored by Villoux. Realm of the Mad God Server Heads shall appoint staff to aid in the administration of their respective server, but these server staff members are not considered members of the system's staff. The Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman shall also appoint up to five Realm of the Mad God Dungeon Directors to aid in hosting system-sponsored dungeon runs. The Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman maintains the right to appoint and demote Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters, Realm of the Mad God Server Heads, Realm of the Mad God Dungeon Directors, Realm of the Mad God guild staff, and Realm of the Mad God server staff as is seen fit.

Phil Clause

Effective March 2012

All Villoux Grand Council Members will be granted an officer position in the Villoux Guild and the Villoux Elite Guild if they meet the Villoux Elite Guild's membership requirements, pursuant to the

Phil Clause of the Unity Ordinance. Grand Council Members are ineligible to hold officer, leader, or founder positions for any other Villoux sponsored Realm of the Mad God guild; however, the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman is required to be recognized as a leader in all Villoux sponsored Realm of the Mad God guilds. It should be clearly noted that Grand Council Members are not considered officers for any Realm of the Mad God guild despite having officer permissions.

Oupas Clause

Effective March 2012

Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters are preferred to have the founder rank within the guild they administrate, but are required to have at least a leader role.

Section 3 - Guild Information

Orcrypt Clause

Effective August 2017

Realm of the Mad God guilds that wish to join the system must meet the following criteria: have at least ten unique users in the guild; have at least ten users of the guild on Villoux's Discord Server; have a guild name that does not violate the KirinaeWindstalker Clause of the Unity, the Spree Clause of the Unity Ordinance, the Icyx Clause of the Unity Ordinance, the Zedl Clause of the Unity Ordinance, or the Pbarron88 Clause of the Unity Ordinance; and receive approval from the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman. Guilds which neglect to maintain these standards will be granted one week to achieve the standards again. The guild will become unaffiliated with Villoux if the guild fails to return to Villoux standards in one week.

Cronus Clause

Effective August 2017

Each Villoux Realm of the Mad God guild will be allotted no less than one private voice channel and one private text channel on Villoux's Discord Server, pursuant to the Orcrypt Clause of the

Discord Ordinance. Additional channels may be granted pursuant to the Orcrypt Clause of the Discord Ordinance. Officials within the Realm of the Mad God Department such as Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters and guild staff do not hold authority on Villoux's Discord Server. It is the responsibility of the Villoux Discord Operation Department to maintain order within the Realm of the Mad God category on Discord. All other information regarding Villoux's Discord Server can be found in the Discord Ordinance. Guilds which neglect to maintain these standards will be granted one week to achieve the standards again. All of the guild's channels will be deleted and the guild will become unaffiliated with Villoux if the guild fail to return to Villoux standards in one week.

Gooky Clause

Effective March 2012

Villoux Realm of the Mad God guilds are eligible for a private channel on Villoux's TeamSpeak, pursuant to the Alch Clause of the TeamSpeak Ordinance. Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters who wish to have a TeamSpeak channel must contact the Executive TeamSpeak Operator to receive their channel.

CatScern Clause

Effective September 2018

The Villoux Server System will operate its own official Realm of the Mad God guild, the Villoux Guild. Any Villoux user is eligible to join the Villoux Guild so long as they are not issued a department ban from the Realm of the Mad God Department or a system ban, meaning there are no membership requirements. The Villoux Guild is exempt from the membership requirements outlined in the Orcrypt Clause of this Ordinance, pursuant to Grand Council Ruling #191998. The Realm of the Mad God Guild Master of the Villoux Guild is directly responsible for the administration of the Villoux Guild.

Villoux's Realm of the Mad God Department will directly operate as many secondary guilds as necessary to ensure all Villouxians have access to an official Villoux Realm of the Mad God Guild in the event membership in the Villoux Guild reaches the in-game capacity of fifty members. The

Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman will determine which of these guilds is most suitable in the event a second official guild is needed. Potential secondary guilds include the Lyllox Guild and the Villoux Elite Guild. The Lyllox Guild is another iteration of the Villoux Guild in that it is open for any Villouxian to join as long as they are on Villoux's Discord Server; however, the Villoux Elite Guild requires its members to have at least 800 alive fame and one 6/8 character. Both the Lyllox Guild and the Villoux Elite Guild are exempt from the membership requirements outlined in the Orcrypt Clause of this Ordinance, pursuant to Grand Council Ruling #192011 and #20549, respectively. The Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters of each guild are directly responsible for the administration of their respective guild.

Danthemanrs Clause

Effective January 2019

Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters will be granted a role on Villoux's Discord Server capable of adding users to a guild membership role, pursuant to the Orcrypt Clause of the Discord Ordinance. Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters who add roles to users other than the membership role of the guild they administrate risk being demoted from their position and being charged with "Abuse of Permissions".

Meowzo Clause

Effective March 2016

Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters must provide weekly reports to the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman. These reports should include the number of users in the guild, the number of users in the guild on Villoux's Discord Server, the leadership of the guild, and any problems facing the guild. Failure to submit these reports will result in the Guild Master's demotion.

Section 4 - Dungeon Running Information

EggTech Clause

Effective September 2017

The Realm of the Mad God category on Villoux's Discord Server offers a private voice channel to groups of users whom wish to rune private tombs, dungeons, shatters, and other events in Realm of the Mad God, the "Dungeon Running Channel", pursuant to the EggTech Clause of the Discord Ordinance. The Dungeon Running Channel may only be used by groups of at least two users to run private dungeons on production Realm of the Mad God. Only users participating in the event may join the channel and users must vacate the channel once the event is over. Use of the channel operates of a first come first serve basis and any Realm of the Mad God Department-sponsored event maintains first rights to use the channel, even if other users are currently occupying it. Users whom meet these standards may contact a Realm of the Mad God Dungeon Director, member of the Discord Operation Department, the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman, or the Executive Discord Operator to utilize the channel.

Fulfi Clause

Effective October 2018

The following criteria must be met, and the following rules must be followed to use the dungeon running channel on Villoux's Discord Server:

- 1) The group must consist of no less than two users
- 2) Only users participating in the event may be in the channel
- 3) The channel may only be used by one group at a time, operating on a first-come first-serve basis
- 4) Users must vacate the channel once the event is over

DrPibb Clause

Effective October 2018

Officially scheduled department events take priority over users' use of the dungeon running channel. Realm of the Mad God Dungeon Directors and the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman maintain the right to vacate the channel in the event users are occupying it during a scheduled dungeon run.

Qmen Clause

Effective October 2018

The Realm of the Mad God Department will host no less than one dungeon run per week. The Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman upon the advice of the Realm of the Mad God Guild Masters and the Realm of the Mad God Dungeon Directors will determine if the dungeon run will be open to the public or closed to a specific guild sponsored by the system.

KingKazmza Clause

Effective April 2017

Users may donate keys to the system for Villoux sponsored Realm of the Mad God dungeon runs. Any user who donates keys must report the donation to the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman who will report the donation to the Villoux Chief of Staff to be added to the system treasury report. Users are not given rewards for their donations, but donations are greatly appreciated by the Realm of the Mad God Department and the system.

Section 5 - Private Server General Information

AdrianZubi Clause

Effective May 2015

The Villoux Server System may host private Realm of the Mad God servers separate from production Realm of the Mad God. These servers will be led by a singular Realm of the Mad God Server Head aided by a Realm of the Mad God server staff. The Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman has authority over Realm of the Mad God Server Heads and the Villoux Chief of Staff through the Villoux Grand Council is the ultimate authority on all Realm of the Mad God servers.

Herorider Clause

Effective June 2016

All Villoux Realm of the Mad God servers shall display their membership in the Villoux Server System in their server's connection message, pursuant to the Highlander Clause of the Unity Ordinance.

Wrench Clause

Effective July 2019

All Villoux Realm of the Mad God servers must offer rewards to users who are a member of both the Minecraft server and Villoux's Discord Server. The rewards will be proposed by the respective server's Realm of the Mad God Server Head and the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman and will be authorized by the Villoux Chief of Staff on the advice of the Executive Discord Operator.

AUGX Clause

Effective June 2016

No Villoux Realm of the Mad God server will be permitted to require users to pay to play on them, pursuant to the CnTexas96 Clause of the Unity Ordinance. Furthermore, the system may not directly request donations from users.

Teemo Clause

Effective June 2016

The Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman may petition the Villoux Grand Council to grant exemption from any of this ordinance's clauses in the event the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman believes the clause compromises the server's theme, pursuant to the Cody Clause of the Unity Ordinance. The server is required to abide by all clauses until exemption is granted by the Villoux Grand Council.

Section 6 - Private Server Staff Structure

Meapy Clause

Effective June 2016

This clause shall outline Villoux's recommended staff structure for server staff, though this clause serves merely as a recommendation and is not required to be followed unless directed otherwise by the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman.

It is recommended that Realm of the Mad God Server Heads appoint a head moderator to aid in the moderation of their respective server. The server may hold as many additional moderators as is necessary. The role of moderators should be to enforce the server's basic rules such as chat and naming restrictions and render punishment against violators of said rules. It should be ensured that moderators cover as many time zones as possible to ensure there is always authority on the server. Moderators should report to the head moderator.

It is recommended that Realm of the Mad God Server Heads also appoint a head admin to aid in the administration of their respective server. The server may hold as many additional admins as is necessary. The role of admins should be higher than that of moderators and, as such, admins should have access to game-altering features not accessible to moderators. Admins should report to the head admin.

Any server not following this model must provide an outline of their staff structure to the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman who must then approve said outline. Once approved, the outline and all server staff shall be noted on the server's respective webpage.

Lunacy Clause

Effective August 2016

The Villoux Chief of Staff and the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman are required to have access to all permissions on all Villoux Realm of the Mad God servers. The Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman will then decide which permissions are accessible by Realm of the Mad God Server Heads and their respective staff. Members of Villoux's System Coding Department may be granted temporary access to permissions or server files at the approval of the respective server's Realm of the Mad God Server Head or the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman.

Spazproof Clause

Effective May 2015

All Villoux Grand Council Members will be granted basic moderator permissions on all Villoux sponsored Realm of the Mad God servers, pursuant to the Smudd Clause of the Unity Ordinance.

Grand Council Members are ineligible to hold any other server staff positions. It should be clearly noted that Grand Council Members are not considered moderators for any Realm of the Mad God server despite having moderation permissions.

Section 7 - Private Server Ban Classifications, Offenses, & Proceedings

Nexe Clause

Effective June 2016

Server staff should always strive to resolve issues without issuing a ban, though they are encouraged to issue a ban when there is no alternative to counteract bad behavior. Users should generally be kicked once from the server at least as a warning before being issued a ban for minor offenses.

IFarmmy Clause

Effective June 2016

Members of server staff who issue server bans must submit a ban report detailing the ban to the respective server's Realm of the Mad God Server Head, pursuant to the IFarmmy Clause of the Unity Ordinance. The ban report should be formatted as follows: username of banned user, Discord client number, nationality of banned user, charge, brief description of the events, date, user that banned the user, banner's rank, user that reported the user, reporter's rank, ban duration. "N/A" should be used when any of the aforementioned information is unavailable. The Realm of the Mad God Server Head will then forward the report to the Realm of the Mad God Department Chairman who will relay it to the Villoux Chief of Staff to be entered into the Villoux User Reports. Failure to submit ban reports may result in a demotion from server staff and a ban for "Abuse of Permissions".

WhyteOwl Clause

Effective August 2017

Bans from Villoux Realm of the Mad God servers and Villoux's Discord Server are independent from one another and do not translate to a ban on the other server. This standard applies to all

other Villoux owned or operated servers as well, e.g. a ban on Villoux's Discord Server does not result in a ban on any Realm of the Mad God server. It should be noted this standard likewise applies to individual Realm of the Mad God servers, e.g. a ban on one Villoux Realm of the Mad God server does not result in a ban from any other Villoux Realm of the Mad God server. It should also be noted users who are issued department bans from the Realm of the Mad God Department are banned from all Realm of the Mad God servers and users who are system banned are banned from all Villoux owned or operated servers, including all Realm of the Mad God servers and Villoux's Discord Server.

Eclipse Clause

Effective June 2016

Users who are banned for multiple offenses will have their ban duration reflect each ban individually, e.g. a user be banned for "Trolling and Refusing to Cooperate" will be banned for three hours opposed to one or two hours. There is no limit as to how many offenses can be registered against one user at a given time.

Silent Clause

Effective July 2019

Bans against users stack on each Villoux Realm of the Mad God server individually. The fourth ban against any user will be issued for one week opposed to the normal ban duration unless the normal ban duration would exceed one week. The fifth ban against any user will be issued for thirty-days opposed to the normal ban duration unless the normal ban duration would exceed thirty-days. The sixth ban against any user will most likely be a permanent ban from the server but it can be issued for thirty-days unless the normal ban duration would exceed thirty-days.

Templox Clause

Effective June 2016

Rules may vary between different Realm of the Mad God Minecraft servers; however, all Villoux Realm of the Mad God servers are required to abide by all clauses outlined in this ordinance. Each Villoux Realm of the Mad God server is required to have a link to the Realm of the Mad God Ordinance and all of their regulations outlined on the server's webpage on Villoux's website. The webpage's link to should advertised in each Villoux Realm of the Mad God server's announcements.

SeaDragnX Clause

Effective June 2016

Members of server staff who intentionally misuse their granted permissions or express intent to cause harm to the server with their permissions will be issued a ban for "Abuse of Permissions" and potentially face a demotion from server. The ban duration for "Abuse of Permissions" ranges from thirty days to a permanent ban depending on the severity of the situation.

Cperalta Clause

Effective June 2016

Users who post information regarding other Realm of the Mad God servers, Realm of the Mad God guilds not sponsored by Villoux, or gaming communities risk being banned for "Advertising". The user does not have to post connection information to another server or community in order to be charged; the mere discussion of exterior communities is prohibited. The ban duration for "Advertising" ranges from one week to a permanent ban depending on the intent of the advertising.

Dallaskirl Clause

Effective June 2016

Users who connect to a Realm of the Mad God server from which they were banned during the duration of said ban will be re-banned for "Ban Evading". The ban duration for "Ban Evading" is a reset of the previous ban duration plus an additional eight hours.

Alch Clause

Effective June 2016

The act of a server staff member accepting money, items, favors, or other goods/services in payment for using his or her position in a certain way will result in the user initiating the transaction being charged with “Bribery” and the server staff member being demoted from their position and being charged with “Abuse of Permissions”. It should be noted that the transaction must have actually taken place in order for this charge to be valid; attempting to bribe a server staff member does not equate to bribery, though it may be punished in other ways. The ban duration for “Bribery” is thirty days.

KratiosSNM Clause

Effective June 2016

Users who are openly aggressive and unruly with server staff may be charged with “Disrespect to Server Staff”. It should be clear noted that having disagreements with members of the server staff or questioning a member of staff for taking an action are not considered disrespect unless done in a hostile or otherwise volatile way. The ban for duration for “Disrespect to Server Staff” is two hours.

Luckyguym Clause

Effective June 2016

Distribution of any pornographic content including links in chat or building pornographic content is strictly prohibited. The KirinaeWindstalker Clause of the Discord Ordinance outlines specific definitions of pornography. The ban duration for “Distribution of Pornography” is one hour.

Ratified Clause

Effective June 2016

The act of intentionally revealing otherwise secret information shall be considered distribution of private information. This charge can range from distributing user’s personal information such as IP addresses, current business or home residences, phone numbers, pictures, real names, or online profiles without the consent of said user. This charge also extends to distributing private information

about the server or potential staff decisions. It should be clearly noted that users may distribute their own personal information to whomever they feel worthy and may not be charged with “Distribution of Private Information” for distributing their own information. The ban duration for “Distribution of Private Information” is one week.

ShadowBoo Clause

Effective June 2016

Users who troll another user multiple times over a period of time or personally attack another user may be charged with “Harassment”. Harassment is inclusive of racism, sexism, homophobia, and other forms of discrimination. The Spree Clause (racism) and the Icyx Clause (homophobia) of the Discord Ordinance should be referred to when determining whether or not a statement is racist or homophobic. The ban duration for “Harassment” is two hours.

Crazycat Clause

Effective June 2016

Intentionally spreading mistruths, speculated gossip, or otherwise made up stories to server staff members shall be considered lying to server staff. It should be noted that this lie must have been perpetrated in a scenario wherein a member of server staff was acting in their official capacity, e.g. responding to a report by a user. This charge cannot be used in cases where role-play is accepted on the server. The ban duration for “Lying to Server Staff” ranges from one-week to thirty-days depending on the severity of the lie.

Phaseout Clause

Effective June 2016

Users may not use proxies, VPNs, or any other form of IP masks on any Villoux Realm of the Mad God server unless granted approval by the Villoux Chief of Staff. Failure to comply with this rule may result in a permanent ban for “Proxy Usage”.

Stoppable Clause

Effective June 2016

Any user who fails to comply with direct orders given to them by members of a Minecraft server's staff are eligible to be charged with "Refusing to Cooperate". This charge can range from refusing to divulge pertinent information to obstruction of justice to any other action that interferes with the server staff's ability to perform their job. The ban duration for "Refusing to Cooperate" is two hours.

Grazey Clause

Effective June 2016

Trolling is defined as intentionally annoying or attempting to annoy other users. The ban duration for "Trolling" is one hour.
