

System Census Ordinance

This Ordinance States:

Effective January 2013

The Villoux Server System will conduct a system census every January, May, and September. The system census will count the number of users in each gaming department and their respective nationalities in order to aid the system in decision-making regarding the times at which events are hosted, the system's sponsored languages, the system's advertising techniques, and other information. It is the responsibility of the members of the Chairman Committee to gather the data for their respective departments. All disputes over users' department definition or nationalities shall be heard and resolved by the Villoux Chief of Staff.

Section 1 - Eligibility

Dr. Baskerville Clause

Effective January 2013

Users must be active on Villoux's Discord Server or Villoux's TeamSpeak Server for one month prior to the start of the system census in order to be recorded in the census for the first time. Users who have been previously recorded must have used either Villoux's Discord Server or Villoux's TeamSpeak Server at least once since the time of the last census.

Duyst Clause

Effective January 2013

Users are defined in one gaming department per census, regardless of how many gaming departments in which they are active. The department in which they are defined is dependent upon which game the user plays the most. Users' department definition may vary between system censuses.

Purple Clause

Effective May 2017

Users who have made donations to the system recorded in the system treasury report two months prior to the start of the system census will be defined in that month's census, regardless of their activity on Discord or TeamSpeak since their donation speaks to their support and interest in Villoux in place of their activity on Discord or TeamSpeak.

BillehRoot Clause

Effective January 2013

Users who are eligible to be counted in the system census but are not members of any of the system's gaming departments will be classified as "non-defined". These users will not be counted towards any gaming department but will be included in the total count of Villoux users. The Misc. Gaming Section Manager is responsible for aiding the Villoux Chief of Staff in determining information about these users since the users are de facto assigned to the Misc. Gaming division of the System Press Department.

KingKazma Clause

Effective May 2019

Users who are issued department bans are ineligible to be defined in departments from which they are currently issued a department ban. Users who only play the game of the department from which they were banned will be defined as "non-defined". Users who have their department ban appealed become re-eligible to be defined in the department from which they were previously banned.

Bloodfreya Clause

Effective January 2013

Users who are issued system bans are ineligible to be counted in any system census during the duration of their system bans. The users become re-eligible to be defined in the system census if their system ban is appealed or pardoned.

Nexe Clause

Effective May 2018

Users who have verifiably passed away are ineligible to be counted in any system census after their death. The last census in which they were defined shall remain the final census in which they are defined.

Villoux Verification Bot Clause

Effective April 2019

Bots on Villoux's Discord Server are ineligible to be counted in any system census as they do not represent an actual user.

Section 2 - Classifications

System Nationality Clause

Effective January 2013

Users will only be defined by nationalities recognized by the System Nationality Ordinance. The System Nationality Ordinance will be used to determine users' nationalities, especially when users' nationalities are in dispute.

Crazycat Clause

Effective January 2014

System staff members who serve a gaming department will be defined in the gaming department which they serve regardless of their activity in other gaming departments, e.g. a League of Legends Tournament Director will be defined in the League of Legends Department without exception. It should be noted this clause only affects system staff members from gaming departments; not system staff members from staff departments.

Section 3 - Authorization

Flosion Clause

Effective January 2015

Each system census must be approved by at least 50% of the Villoux Grand Council. It is the responsibility of the Chief of Staff to ensure that the censuses for January, May, and September are finalized before the respective Grand Council meeting for each aforementioned month.

ChewOnDiss Clause

Effective January 2013

The system census results will be read at the corresponding House of Players meeting as the “System Census Report”, pursuant to the ChewOnDiss Clause of the House of Players Ordinance. The system census report should always begin with an explanation of the requirements for users to be counted in the census per the System Census Ordinance, the total number of users in the system as of the current census versus the last census, the percentage national representation in Villoux, the ranking of each gaming department, and the number of users defined in each gaming department and the misc. gaming section. The system census report will be presented by the Villoux Chief of Staff or the Chairman Committee Speaker.
