

# System Commercialist Ordinance

This Ordinance States:

*Effective October 2019*

The specific regulations for the System Commercialist division of the System Press Department are outlined in this ordinance in order to provide further clarity of the expectations and limitations of Villoux's System Commercialists. This ordinance does not fully cover all material listed in the System Staff Ordinance or the Unity Ordinance, which also heavily governs the System Commercialist division's administration. This ordinance is also not completely reflective of all other ordinances within the Villoux Bill of Ordinances that may also hold some governance over this division. The Villoux Chief of Staff is the ultimate enforcer of all ordinances within the Villoux Bill of Ordinances, but the System Commercialist Manager and the Executive System Press Officer are directly responsible for the enforcement of this ordinance within the System Commercialist division. This ordinance exclusively affects the System Commercialist division of the System Press Department and is not applicable elsewhere.

## Section 1 - General Information

Smax Clause

*Effective October 2019*

The Executive System Press Officer upon the advice of the System Commercialist Manager is responsible for the hiring and demotion of System Commercialists, though the Villoux Chief of Staff also maintains the right to be involved in this process, pursuant to the Dr. Baskerville Clause of the System Staff Ordinance.

Dr. Baskerville Clause

*Effective October 2019*

The System Commercialist division is directly administrated by the Executive System Press Officer and the System Commercialist Manager. System Commercialists are expected to report to the System Commercialist Manager for instructions

Godson710420 Clause

*Effective October 2019*

System Commercialists, like all members of Villoux's staff are not inherently compensated for their work, but may receive payment if an agreement is reached with the Villoux Chief of Staff, pursuant to the SLVRDLLR Clause of the System Staff Ordinance and the Afecter Clause of the Grand Council Ordinance

Einstein Clause

*Effective October 2019*

System Commercialists maintain the right to accept donations from viewers for Villoux-sponsored video content. Donations received by System Commercialists are not subject to regulation by the Villoux Grand Council.

**Section 2 - Content Regulation**

Hetoup Clause

*Effective October 2019*

System Commercialists who fail to maintain the following regulations on the content they produce are subject to demotion from their position and further punishment pursuant to other ordinances within the Villoux Bill of Ordinances.

Biko Clause

*Effective October 2019*

System Commercialists are required to follow the terms of service of the respective video platform, e.g. the Twitch terms of service for System Commercialists who stream on Twitch. It should be noted terms of service for platforms other than the platform on which content is produced are not binding, e.g. the Twitch terms of service do not apply to content produced on YouTube.

Lluke156 Clause

*Effective October 2019*

System Commercialists are not permitted to advertise or discuss other communities while they are producing official content for Villoux, however, System Commercialists are free to promote other communities in non-Villoux related videos. Refer to the Lluke156 Clause of the Discord Ordinance for further information on Villoux's definition of "Advertising".

Pbarron88 Clause

*Effective October 2019*

The language and visual restrictions outlined in the Pbarron88 Clause, Spree Clause, Icyx Clause, KirinaeWindstalker Clause, and Zedl Clause of the Discord Ordinance are to be respected on all video content produced for Villoux, including chat messages and emotes, names, and avatars. System Commercialists who violate any of these clauses in video content produced for Villoux will be immediately removed from their position and may face additional subject pursuant to the Discord Ordinance. System Commercialists who violate any of these clauses in non-Villoux related content also highly risk being removed from their position. Refer to the aforementioned clauses in the Discord Ordinance for specific regulations.

Floflorian Clause

*Effective October 2019*

All video content produced for Villoux must be in one of the system's officially sponsored languages (English, French, and Spanish), pursuant to the Quarkk Clause of the Unity Ordinance.

### *Section 3 - Villoux-Sponsored Platform Chats*

#### Wrench Clause

*Effective October 2019*

All relevant clauses within the Discord Ordinance are applicable on any chat service offered by a streaming platform on which a System Commercialist operates with a Villoux account. Users who violate the Discord Ordinance in chat risk being issued a ban from Villoux's Discord Server as well as a chat ban.

#### Cake Clause

*Effective October 2019*

All messages posted in a chat service offered by a streaming platform on which a System Commercialist operates with a Villoux account must be in one of the system's officially sponsored languages (English, French, and Spanish), pursuant to the Quarkk Clause of the Unity Ordinance.

#### Cronus Clause

*Effective October 2019*

Moderators will be appointed to manage chat services offered by a streaming platform on which a System Commercialist operates with a Villoux account. These moderators will be Villoux Discord Operators, the Discord Operative Manager, and any other user appointed to serve as such by the System Commercialist Manager and the Executive System Press Officer or the Villoux Chief of Staff. All Villoux Grand Council Members will be granted basic moderator permissions on chat services offered by a streaming platform on which a System Commercialist operates with a Villoux account, pursuant to the Smudd Clause of the Unity Ordinance. It should be clearly noted that Grand Council Members are not considered moderators for any chat despite having moderation permissions.

Zombieslayer935 Clause

*Effective October 2019*

Chat moderators maintain the right to issue chat bans against users who violate the Discord Ordinance with time restrictions pursuant to the Elly Clause of the Discord Ordinance within a chat service offered by a streaming platform on which a System Commercialist operates.

SLVRDLLR Clause

*Effective October 2019*

It is highly recommended all System Commercialists who do not stream on a Villoux account enforce all of this section's clauses within their own chat. Egregious violations of this section in non-Villoux-sponsored chats may result in the System Commercialist being removed from their position.

***Section 4 - Administration of Events***

BrentMar123 Clause

*Effective October 2019*

All Villoux users who appear in any video content produced by a System Commercialist must provide their consent to appear in the content in order for content containing them to be published. This consent does not have to be individually obtained.

Earl554 Clause

*Effective October 2019*

Users who are not System Commercialists who appear in video content produced for Villoux are required to abide by all regulations outlined in this ordinance. Failure to comply with this clause will result in a ban from Villoux's Discord Server for the violation and may result in further punishment.

Fufli Clause

*Effective October 2019*

Department Chairmen are encouraged to request System Commercialists be assigned to stream events their respective departments host. Department Chairmen will coordinate System Commercialists' availability with the Executive System Press Officer.
